# COMMON DATES AND DEADLINES

- Beginning of the academic year: **2 October 2023**
- Beginning of teaching activities: **2 October 2023**

The competent educational structures, giving notice via their website by Tuesday 29 August 2023, can bring forward the start of educational activities to **Monday 25 September 2023**.

The competent educational structures, **giving notice** via their website by **Monday 18 September 2023**, can postpone the start and end of educational activities.

If required by the procedures for admission to study courses with **restricted access at national level**, the teaching activities of these study courses **may begin after Monday 2 October 2023**.

The beginning of the lessons will be announced on the website of the school/department/course.

## ENROLLMENT AND ENROLLMENT FOR YEARS FOLLOWING THE FIRST

The enrollment dates for the first year of the courses (enrollments) are determined through the **Admission Notices**.

Enrollment in years subsequent to the first takes place **by Friday 29 September 2023** with the payment of the **first fee**.

Students who **graduate by Saturday 16 December 2023** are **exempt from paying the first fee**.

## FINAL EXAM

In each of the three periods it is mandatory to provide at least one call unless otherwise stated in ministerial decrees.

- First period - from Monday 5 February 2024 to Tuesday 30 April 2024
- Second period - from Monday 3 June 2024 to Saturday 20 July 2024
- Third period A+B- from Monday 2 September 2024 to Saturday 14 December 2024

### **COURSES OF STUDY PRIOR TO THE D.M. 509/99**

- Extraordinary session a.y. 2022/23 - from Monday 5 February 2024 to Tuesday 30 April 2024
- Summer session - from Monday 3 June 2024 to Saturday 20 July 2024
- Autumn session - from Monday 2 September 2024 to Saturday 14 December 2024

# PERIOD FOR SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO THE FINAL EXAM

Students up-to-date with the payment of fees can submit the application for admission to the final exam by the following dates:

## **FIRST PERIOD - GRADUATIONS FROM MONDAY 5 FEBRUARY 2024 TO TUESDAY 30 APRIL 2024**

- Deadline for graduation application: from Monday 6 November 2023 to Thursday 11 January 2024
- Deadline for taking exams: 15 days before the start of the graduation session
- Payment of fees: first and second fee 2023/24

## **SECOND PERIOD: GRADUATIONS FROM MONDAY 3 JUNE 2024 TO SATURDAY 20 JULY 2024**

- Deadline for graduation application: from Monday 26 February 2024 to Tuesday 7 May 2024
- Deadline for taking exams: 15 days before the start of the graduation session
- Payment of fees: first, second and third fee 2023/24

## **THIRD PERIOD A: GRADUATIONS FROM MONDAY 2 SEPTEMBER 2024 TO SATURDAY 26 OCTOBER 2024**

- Deadline for graduation application: from Monday 3 June 2024 to Tuesday 16 July 2024
- Deadline for taking exams: 15 days before the start of the graduation session
- Payment of fees: first, second and third fee 2023/24

## **THIRD PERIOD B: GRADUATIONS FROM MONDAY 28 OCTOBER 2024 TO SATURDAY 14 DECEMBER 2024**

- Deadline for graduation application submission: from Monday 19 August 2024 to Tuesday 08 October 2024
- Deadline for taking exams: 15 days before the start of the graduation session
- Payment of fees: first, second and third fee 2023/24

The graduation sessions and the deadlines for submitting the graduation application of the courses in the **Health Professions** are established by the competent educational structures, having acquired the ministerial indications.

## PLEASE NOTE

- In the event that the student is unable to graduate within the first session and wishes to submit the graduation application for the next session of the same period, he must notify the Student Career Office, according to the procedures indicated on the University website.
- The dates of the individual graduation sessions must be established and communicated by the competent educational structures to the Student Career Office at least 30 days before the announcement date.
- Students enrolled in a Degree Course in Health Professions (Classes 1-4SNT), who obtain the title in a graduation session starting by Tuesday 30 April 2024 and who have acquired all the certificates of attendance by the month of September 2023, are exempt from paying the first fee for the a.y. 2023/2024.
- Students enrolled in the last year of a course of study with regulations prior to the D.M. 509/99 who graduate by Tuesday 30 April 2024 are exempt from paying the first fee for the a.y. 2023/2024.
- To be admitted to the final exam, it is mandatory to make all payments due within seven days prior to the date of the graduation session (Student Career Regulations, art. 24).

## ACTIVITY ON QUARTERS

Each course of study must provide at least 9 weeks of effective educational activity within the periods indicated. The formal fulfilments of verbalization/registration of the profit assessments for the study courses according to the D.M. 509/99 and 270/04 can begin before the start of the two official exam sessions, at the end of the 9 weeks of face-to-face activity.

## FIRST QUARTER

- Teaching: from Monday 2 October 2023 to Saturday 2 December 2023
- Profit assessments: from Monday, December 4, 2023 to Wednesday, December 20, 2023

## SECOND QUARTER

- Teaching: from Monday 8 January 2024 to Saturday 16 March 2024

- Profit assessments: from Thursday 27 June 2024 to Saturday 27 July 2024

### **RECOVERY**

- Profit assessments: from Monday, August 19, 2024 to Saturday, September 21, 2024

### **SESSION FOR GRADUATING BY 14 DECEMBER 2024**

- Profit Assessments: Tuesday, October 1, 2024 to Saturday, November 23, 2024

## PLEASE NOTE

- The competent teaching structures can authorize teachers to open extraordinary exam sessions outside the periods established above, to students outside the course of the system prior to the Ministerial Decree 509/99 and to repeating students of D.M. 509/99 and 270/04, provided that this does not interfere with normal teaching activities
- For study courses activated in inter-university mode with foreign universities (issue of double degree or joint degree), the competent teaching structures can provide for assessments of profit and for the final exams, extraordinary sessions outside the periods established above.
- The graduation sessions and the deadlines for submitting the graduation application for the health professions degree courses are set by the competent teaching structures, having acquired the ministerial indications, taking into account the needs of the University educational planning.
