TEACHING MODALITY

Teaching activities will resume **in presence** and in **full capacity**, in compliance with all safety regulations (mandatory face mask and forbidden access with respiratory diseases symptoms and body temperature over 37,5°).

Prerequisites:	two preparatory courses are required. However, the scholastic knowledge of the following subjects is considered fundamental fo
	an adequate learning: units of measure, atomic structure, chemical bonds, nature of acids and base, pH, structure of hydrocarbons.
Target skills and knowledge:	Students should acquire theoretical and practical knowledge in the main topics of general chemistry, organic chemistry and biochemistry. These skills will be useful in the subsequent courses and in the professional life after having achieved the Degree
Examination methods:	Students demonstrating insufficient knowledge of chemistry may have to fulfill the OFA (additional educational obligation) in chemistry. These students will not be admitted to the exam of Applied Chemistry and Biochemistry until they have fulfilled this obligation.
	The course examination encompasses two written tests, both containing multiple choice, open questions and excercizes. One test will deal with general and organic chemistry, the other with biochemistry. The final grade is given by the mean of the two tests, plus a possible increase (1-2 points) dependent on the evaluation of laboratory activity. Students can choose to take the two tests during the semester, one at a time, or at the official examination sessions. If one test is not sufficient, only that test must be repeated. A test with a sufficient score is valid until the end of the Academic Year.

If no password ("*Chiave di iscrizione*") was set by the Professor, you will just need to click on **ISCRIVIMI** ("Register me").

- See your **Exam results** and refuse the grade (only if you are not happy with it!!)









STUDY PLAN for Exchange students:

Procedure to add the course units to your **ONLINE BOOKLET**

- You will be able to sign up for exams and to record the grades only if the course units are already included in your Online Booklet
- Italian Language course: it will be added to the booklet of all exchange students. You do not have to select it in the study plan procedure.
- The study plan must correspond to your LA
- You can change your Study Plan as many times as you need, but we ask you to complete the first version no later than 31st October

Procedure to add the course units to your **ONLINE BOOKLET**

DO NOT FORGET TO SIGN UP FOR EXAMS ON UNIWEB!

- > You can sign up only for the course units in your ONLINE BOOKLET on Uniweb
- You can sign up during the "Sign up session" only: usually between 10 and 4 days before the exam (please do not wait until the very last day!)
- It is mandatory to sign up for exams ON UNIWEB even if a professor asks you to sign up on Moodle – in this case you need to REGISTER TWICE
- If you take a "pre-appello" (i.e. the professor allows you to take the exam in advance, outside the official session) you STILL have to sign up on Uniweb for one of the official dates of the exam!
- IT IS FORBIDDEN TO ASK PROFESSORS FOR OTHER "APPELLI" OR DATES, especially if you take course units offered by other SCHOOLS

- The grade will be visible on UNIWEB > EXAM RESULTS BOARD
- > A grade between **18 (min)** and **30 (max)** means you have passed the exam.
- It is possible to reject a grade within 7 days from the publication of the result (for instructions download our GUIDE "How to refuse a grade" available at this link:

CLASS ATTENDANCE - 1

"Do all classes have mandatory attendance?"

"If we have overlapping classes how can we manage attendance if they're all mandatory?"

Very few classes are mandatory, so you can check if you are allowed not to attend lessons. If it's still not possible you will have to change your LA/Study Plan.

"How do I gain access to Moodle and the lecture?"

The responsible professor will explain how to access the online classes in the course unit Moodle page.

"if a course is available for the entire year, is it possible to attend it from the second semester?" In annual courses the programme is annual, so if you want to join in for the second semester you need to ask the responsible professor first.

"There are some courses which have 3 instead of 2 lessons every week. Do we get more credits for attending these courses or is it the same?"

"If I understand it well in a courses' timetable if there are lessons 3 or 4 times a week that means we can choose from them. How can we check that how many lessons should we attend per week?" It's not a list of classes you can choose from, they are all part of the programme, so all the classes should be attended.







CLASS ATTENDANCE - 2

"It is normal to go to difference departments to attend classes? We have enough time to change one for another, for example, if I have one class at the philosophy department and the other one is at the law department?"

Yes, it is normal because exchange students can change courses from different degree courses and Departments, so the schedules are not organised to be able to attend all the course units, as it is for degree courses course units of a given year.

"A course of mine was accepted in my LA but I cannot find it when I'm looking for its timetable. Does it mean the course will not be given in this semester?"

If in the course catalogue the course is on offer for the a.y. 21/22 it means that it will be held. Probably the timetable is not available yet.







CLASS ATTENDANCE - 3

"In the course catalogue it says my activities start on 4th of October but on my timetable they start next week. Which one is the right one?"

You can refer to the timetable.

"The timetable for the courses of the second semester is already available? I search for said courses and they don't appear, I'm only able to see the ones for the first semester." Not yet, the timetable of the second semester will be available a few weeks before the beginning of courses of the second semester.







EXAMS - 1

"What's happening after you reject a grade? Will you retake the exam?"

You can take the exam in another date ("appello") of the exam session.

"Can my hometown university see if I did an exam another time to get a better grade?"

No, in the booklet you will register only the better grade, so in the Transcript of Records that your University will receive only this grade will appear.

"Can we already register for the exams?"

No, you can sign up during the "Sign up session" only: usually between 10 and 4 days before the exam.

"What is the general mode of writing exams in Italy? Writing, Report writing, Presentation, Face-face interaction? or a combination of these?"

It depends on the course unit.

"I wanted to ask if we can retake exams in the same exam period/session or we have just one chance in one exam period?"

Yes, you can retake the exam in the same exam period (you have two dates per session).





EXAMS - 2

"For doing "pre-appello" we need to apply somewhere like for the official dates some days before?"

The responsible professor will tell you how to sign up, it may be in Uniweb or in Moodle only. In case it's only in Moodle, you must sign up on Uniweb later in an official session to have your grade registered.

"The exams are mandatory for all the courses or there is some courses where is not necessary? Like if we pass the test?"

All the course units have some type of final examination (written, oral, etc.).

"In case of different modules, the exams for both will be in the exam session or when a module finishes we need to do the exam?"

You need to see how it's organised in the course unit page in Moodle, but usually the final examination of each module is held in the exam session.

"If the dates of exams are not published yet, how can we know that two exams (of courses from different schools) are not going to be on the same day? And what would happen in that case?"

You need to wait until the dates are published and then you need to sign in for the different exams in different dates (there in more than one date you can choose from in each session).





COURSE CATALOGUE

"If in the educational offer the syllabus is not available how can we see it?"

You can wait until the start of classes and if it's still not available you can send an email to the responsible Professor.

"I have some subjects without any information about exams, units, etc. and without teacher assigned. There will this information be in next days or who could I contact to know that information?"

It means that a teacher was not yet assigned to this course unit, for further info ask the Mobility Desk at your School/Department.

"How do I know if I am not allowed to take a course? (if it is not restricted for exchange students). Also, does a restriction for Erasmus Student include ARQUS students?"

You should check in the courses catalogue where there it is written "Course Unit for Erasmus students". Also you can refer to the guide "How to choose courses at Unipd" and if the course has been approved in your LA it means that you can attend it.

Argus students are exchange students, like Erasmus students, that "tag" refers to all exchange students.





LEARNING AGREEMENT

"If there is a problem with our learning agreement, is there a deadline to when this has to be fix or re-approved by?"

You should change the LA within one month from the start of the classes.

"Do we need to select anything on the Class Timetable or anywhere else if we want to write our master thesis? Or is it sufficient that it is written in our learning agreement?"

You do not need to use Moodle or Uniweb or the Class Timetable if you are only doing thesis work, just agree the activities with your local thesis supervisor.

"If I am at the department of political sciences can I choose a course from the department of psychology for example?"

Yes, you are allowed to choose courses from different Schools/Departments.





MOODLE

"Should we anticipate our professors that we are going to attend their courses before the beginning of classes in order to get the password for the course in Moodle (if required) or they already know about us attending their lessons and we will be provided the password automatically?"

We advise that you register in all your course units in Moodle, if a password is required you need to write to the responsible professor to ask for it.

"One of my courses does not have the address of Moodle site in the e-learning section. It is normal, and should I wait just some time?"

"I can't find my courses in Moodle for 2021/22. Is it possible that they are not yet available?" You should wait a few more days, or you can find the course directly from the Department's/School's Moodle website: <u>https://www.unipd.it/elearning</u>. Or ask for further info to the Mobility Desk at your School/Department.

"For registering in Moodle we should have first filled the study plan or can happen later?"

"If we want to make changes on the LA, which courses should we register first? I want to make a change in my Learning Agreement, but it has to be accepted yet, and I am not sure it will be ready for the first week of classes. So, should I register to the courses from my first LA, or the ones that I want to put in my "second" LA?"

The Study Plan, the LA and Moodle are not directly connected, you should do all these procedures ASAP, in the order suggested by this presentation.





STUDY PLAN

"Do we have to fill in the study plan for all the year or only for the first semester? Because the schedules from the second semester are not available yet"

For the moment you can add only the courses of the first semester. You will change the study plan later, when the timetable of the second semester will be available.

"Can I include courses in my booklet that are not yet in my LA? If I'm planning to change it?"

It is better that you change your Learning Agreement first, then you fill in the study plan, when you are sure about the courses you want to attend. In any case you should fill in the first study plan by 31st October.

"So we can change our study plan until the 31th of October but so won't we miss some courses during this period?"

You should fill in the first version of your study plan by 31st October. The study plan is not related to class attendance, so you will not miss classes.

"Could we fill the study plan after the exams were published to then sign up for the exam? If we switched some course for instance"

No, we suggest you not to wait until the exam session, but to fill in the study plan earlier, because some problems may occur and the risk is that you are not able to sit the exam.







LANGUAGE CERTIFICATES/ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSE - 1

"Do we obtain the A1 Italian certificate if we pass the exam of the free Italian course for Erasmus? Should we modify the LA to add this course?"

"Do we also need to add Italian language course (The Language center) to our study plan?"

The attendance certificate from the course of Italian language held at the Language Centre cannot be used as language certificate to attend classes held in Italian. You can add the course to your LA, the biannual course awards 3 ECTS credits.

"I have forgotten including the italian course at the LA, is it necessary to change it and add it in order to obtain the certificate of it?"

If you pass the final examination you will obtain the attendance certificate from the Language Centre even if the "Italian language lab" is not included in your LA.







LANGUAGE CERTIFICATES/ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSE - 2

"For the IT language certificate the OLS free course is enough? And for the english one what can we provide? I've never done a level evaluation exam but I know some are quite expensive"

"I have done the OLS Test in Italian and send you at the beginning of my application only italian language certificates. But I will attend 1 course that is hold in english. Do I need to send you also a certificate of english? Is a IELTS enough (even if it is a bit over 2 years ago?), or my english level written in my high school diploma? My home university told me, that it is enough to attend OLS in the main language italian."

We accept the following documents as proof of language knowledge for the attendance of classes held in English and in Italian: official language certificates (i.e. TOEFL, IELTS, Cambridge University, etc.), attendance certificates of intensive courses, certificates issued by University officers/professors attesting your language proficiency level, transcript of records including language exams results, OLS test results. Language requirements: B1 English level for students attending course units held in English; A2 Italian level for students attending course units held in English; A2 Italian
