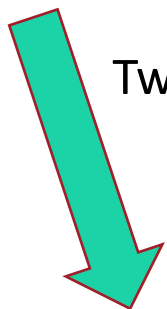

ITALIAN LANGUAGE LAB - ENROLMENT

**I have "Italian Language Lab - L2" on my Learning Agreement. Is that the right choice to attend the CLA classes?
Does it mean I am already registered or I have to enroll in the website?**

Yes, it is correct to write ""Italian Language Lab - L2" in your LA for the CLA classes. However, you still have to enroll in the webpage:

I accidentally chose the "Erasmus PLUS" option when applying for a language course instead of the "Erasmus + Action KA107", can I somehow tell my teacher or does it not matter? Should I apply one more time and select the correct option?

No, don't worry, it is not necessary to inform the teacher. You do not have to apply again. It does not make any difference for the Biannual course, which is open to both student categories.

I enrolled in the Italian Language course but I didn't receive a confirmation e-mail or any information about the course dates or timetable. How can I know I am enrolled?

You will not receive any confirmation email.

Shortly before the start of the classes, you will have to go the webpage:

<http://cla.unipd.it/en/courses/italian-courses/biannual-courses/>

and confirm the class in the section "Class publication and confirmation".

You are not enrolled until you have completed the class choice.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

ITALIAN LANGUAGE LAB

Can this course be taken only in this first semester?

No, the biannual course is available each semester.

I already enrolled but I can't find my Italian class in my class schedule, how can I know when the class is?

You will have to confirm the class before it starts and choose it according to the timetable that best suits you. You won't find CLA's classes in Unipd's schedule and in OrariApp! Those are only for the course units in the Course Catalogue.

If during the lessons we realize that our level does not correspond to the level we chose, are we able to change it if we find it too easy or difficult?

Yes, you can discuss that with your teacher and decide together if you have to change your class level.

Do we get the certificate of attendance if we do not succeed in the final test?

Yes, you will get a certificate of attendance, but you will not receive any ECTS and the course will not be registered in the Final Transcript of Records.

In case of not passing the exam, we have a second chance to obtain the 3 ECTS?

It is not a usual request, but in case you don't pass the final test you can ask the teacher.

ITALIAN LANGUAGE LAB AND STUDY PLAN, LA

Do we have to add the Italian language course to our Study Plan in our UniWeb account?

No, it's not necessary, the Italian Language Lab is automatically added to your Booklet in Uniweb, so you do not need to add it through the Study Plan procedure.

The 3 ECTS that I receive from the course, can I add them to my LA?

Yes, if your University will recognise them you can add it to the LA, the course unit name is "Italian language Lab", no course unit code.

Do we need to mention the language course in our LA or is it voluntary? I won't get credits for it at my home university and I don't need it to complete the 30 ECTS for Erasmus.

In this case you don't need to add it to your LA.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

BASIC COURSES IN OTHER LANGUAGES

Can I take French or German courses and get credits to add to my learning agreement?

The courses offered in other languages are introductory and informal courses, during which you will get familiar with the new language. There isn't a final examination and you will not get any credit for it, therefore you cannot add them to your Learning Agreement. Only the "Italian language lab – L2" biannual course may be added to the LA and awards credits.

How can we register for more basic courses in languages other than Italian? The deadlines are the same?

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Do I have to do the test before choosing a course level or is it okay to just choose it, because I already know my level from an other language test done a few weeks ago
The test is not mandatory.

I did the self-assessment test and the feedback shows the percentage result but it does not say if it is the right level.

The percentage refers to the level you selected before starting the test. If you have scored a very high or a very low percentage, you can take another test in the higher or lower level in order to know which is the most accurate.

CLASS TIMETABLE CLASH AND CHOICE OF CLASSES

If we need to change our LA after the confirmation of our classes, can we switch classes if new courses collide in the hours?

Can I register now and then drop out if I find it impossible to attend?

Hello :) I have already enrolled for one of the Italian classes and I am worried they the class will collide with my study plan. Will there be many options for one level or will I maybe have to switch the level? thank you

You are not registered until you have chosen the class, which you will have to do about 10 days-1 week before the classes start. There will be more than one timetable option for each level. By then you will already know the timetable of your Unipd classes, so you should be able to decide if you can/want to attend the Italian language lab. We ask you to make a decision and complete the enrolment only if you are sure to attend, because the places are limited and many students are not able to take part in the course and will not be able to join later. Of course if you have to drop the course for a serious and unforeseen reason, you can do it.

CILS

Hello, I would like to ask about the fee of CILS exams and Certification

Fees vary depending on the level, from 40 Euros to 160 Euros.

IELTS

I would like to know whether the Certificate of the IELTS expires?

It technically expires because IELTS cannot guarantee that the test results will be saved in their database after 2 years, but depending on what you will use it for, it may still be accepted (but maybe not verified with IELTS).
