



TYPES OF SELF-CERTIFICATION:

Within the meaning of art. 40 of Italian Presidential Decree DPR no. 445/2000 as amended by art. 15 of Lay no. 183 dated 12 November 2011, starting from 1 January 2012 **Public administration and public service providers can no longer request or accept certificates issued by other public offices from private individuals.**

Therefore, information on status, personal qualities and facts must be provided in a statement in lieu of certificate (art. 46 of DPR no. 445/2000) or of affidavit (art. 47 of DPR no. 445/2000).

Public administration and public service providers not accepting self-certifications are in **breach of official duty.**

For enrolled students:

- Insurance
- Self-certification of enrolment and transcript of records
- Self-certification of tuition fees per calendar year (current and previous year).

For graduates:

- Self-certification of academic qualification and transcript of records
- Self-certification of tuition fees per calendar year (current and previous year).
