## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR BENEFITS RELATING TO SCIENTIFIC DEGREE PROGRAMMES A.Y. 2020/2021

### PREMISE

In compliance with the Italian Ministerial Decree no. 989/2019 (Anx. 2 Degree Programmes of scientific-technological areas), and to support enrolments in degree programmes of national or EU interest, the University of Padua offers benefits to students enrolled in specific degree programmes.

### 1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In A.Y. 2020/21 specific benefits are offered to students enrolled in degree programmes of the following classes:

To be selected students must meet the following requirements:

1. **enrolment** in the **second and third year** of the above-mentioned degree programmes, in academic year 2020/21 within 30 October 2020.
2. **merit factor**: according to merit factor as at 10 August 2020.
3. **economic status** as per ISEE certificate (*equivalent economic status indicator*).

Students will be fully or partially exempted from tuition fees, **up to € 1,000.00 maximum**, according to their ranking and the resources available.

## 2. CRITERIA FOR THE RANKING LIST

The ranking list will be drawn up according to students' merit factor (set forth by the call for applications for regional scholarship A.Y. 2020/2021) and economic status (as per ISEE acquired by the University through the Application for benefits A.Y. 2020/21 submitted via UNIWEB), to different extents.

Students can score up to 100 points.

A maximum of 70 points can be awarded for the **merit factor** as per the following table:

Merit factor	Score
Higher than 70	70
Between 60 - 70	60
Between 50 - 60	50
Between 40 - 50	40
Between 30 - 40	30
Between 20 - 30	20
Between 10 - 20	10
Lower than 10	0

A maximum of 30 points can be awarded for **economic status** as per the following table:

ISEE	Score
Greater than € 60,000.00	0
Between € 50,000.00 - 60,000.00	5
Between € 40,000.00 - 50,000.00	10
Between € 30,000.00 - 40,000.00	15
Between € 20,000.00 - 30,000.00	20
Between € 10,000.00 - 20,000.00	25
Under € 10,000.00	30

The ranking lists, drawn up in reverse order from the highest to the lowest overall score, will be published by 30 November 2020 on the dedicated section at [www.unipd.it/esoneri-studenti](http://www.unipd.it/esoneri-studenti).

The overall score is the sum of the points awarded to students for their merit factor and their economic status, as stated above.

Should students achieve the same overall score, the individual merit factor will prevail.

## 3. HOW EXEMPTIONS ARE APPLIED

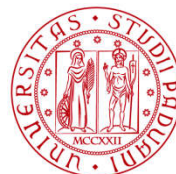
The full or partial exemption is applied on the second and third instalment starting from December.

Should the University owe students money, following payment of instalments in full before any fee reduction and/or fee-waivers were applied, refunds are given.

Refunds will be credited to students' bank account or prepaid card, provided the bank account number (IBAN) has been entered into students' personal area on Uniweb ("Home, Master Data, Refund methods, Edit Bank Account Refund Data"). Students must be holders or joint holders of the bank account or the prepaid card; bank account numbers of third parties, parents included, are not accepted.

It is also possible for students to enter the IBAN of their University Flash Card, received by post following enrolment, provided the card has been upgraded to a "Flash Up Studio" prepaid card at any Intesa Sanpaolo branch.

If students reside abroad, their Italian address must be entered into personal area on UNIWEB, under "Home, Master data, Modify domicile address"; if not, no refunds will be possible.



#### **4. PERSON APPOINTED TO OVERSEE THE PROCEDURE AND DATA PROCESSING**

Pursuant to art. 4 of law 241, dated 7 August 1990 (New rules on administrative procedures and right to access administrative documents) and subsequent amendments, Dr. Alessandra Biscaro, Head of the Student Service Office, is appointed to oversee the administrative procedure.

Candidates may exercise their right to access the competition records following the procedures set forth by Italian Presidential Decree no. 184, dated 12 April 2006 (Regulations on accessing administrative documents in compliance with item V of law 241/90).

The personal data collected for the purposes outlined in this call for applications is processed in compliance with EU Regulation no. 679, dated 27 April 2016, (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR).
