### **Death Studies & The end of Life - For the intervention of support and the accompanying**

Professional outlets: The Master trains professional roles such as:

Experts who can cooperate with health services for palliative care; Experts for the local services that use networks of self-help and volunteering; Experts in thanatology counseling and support for the death and dying.

The participant acquires: knowledge of how the traumatic and natural death are represented individually and socially, with attention to the historical development and cultural differences of its symbol; ability of planning, implementation and evaluation of educational programs related to the processing of the meaning of death; ability of managing help relationships with the dying and his/her family members in individual and/or group basis; expertise in management of working groups with physicians, psychologists, nurses, trainers, educators, social workers; ability to recognize the social need as regards death and mourning within hospital departments, territorial structures, private institutions and in the area.
