## Short Profile of the speakers

**Dragana Avramov**, is Director of Population and Social Policy Consultants, Brussels. Trained in sociology (PhD), political sciences (MA), cultural anthropology, and journalism. She studied and worked in Belgium, Italy, France, UK and former Yugoslavia. She has more than 20 years experience in Social sciences and humanities research and evaluation of research. Special focus of her current research is in the area of sociology of knowledge and in particular the impact of scientific research for policy development [impact-ev.eu/](http://impact-ev.eu/). Publications include 14 books and over 70 scientific articles in several languages (English, French, German, Serbian) including the forward looking study Global Europe 2050, co-authored in 2012 [http://ec.europa.eu/research/social-sciences/pdf/global-europe-2050-report\\_en.pdf](http://ec.europa.eu/research/social-sciences/pdf/global-europe-2050-report_en.pdf) and Evolution Science and Ethics in the Third Millennium, Springer forthcoming 2017. She has been working as **independent expert for the European Commission** on evaluation and policy review since 1999 (DG Research, DG CNNECT, DGEAC, REA, EACEA, TEN-T EA, INEA). She has been **evaluator and Panel Chair for Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions** in FP6, FP7 and H2020.

**Ciro Franco** worked from 1998 to February 2005 at the Italian Ministry of Education, University and Research, in particular at the National Council for the Evaluation of University System (CNVSU).

From March 2005 to 2012 he worked at the Consorzio per l'Area di Ricerca Scientifica e Tecnologica di Trieste (AREA Science Park), as head of the Office "Coordination and internationalisation of regional research institutions".

Since 2007 he has been **expert and Vice Chair, on behalf of the European Commission, within Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions** evaluation exercise, both in FP7 and in Horizon 2020 (Actions Individual Fellowships, Innovative Training Networks, Co-funding of regional, national and international Programmes).

From December 2012 to February 2014 he was Head of Technology Transfer Office (TTO) at Politecnico of Milano. From March 2014 to June 2016, he was in charge of the Technical Directorate "Promotion and valorisation of Research" at OGS (Istituto Nazionale di Oceanografia e Geofisica Sperimentale - National Institute of Oceanography and Experimental Geophysics). Currently he works at Sapienza University of Rome, as Head of Fund Raising Office, where he deals with the promotion and support of national and international research, as well as with the support for drafting research agreements of Sapienza with public and private institutions.
