

Strategic competences for young researchers

GENERAL LEARNING GOAL

Today the importance of Soft Skills is strongly at the center of attention of company organization and always more frequently object of analysis in recruiting and selection process of young people.

PhD Educational week on Transferable skills, strategic competences for young researchers offers PhD students of Padova training activities aimed at strengthening the so–called *Transferable skills*, i.e. interdisciplinary knowledge in the fields of research design, communication, and relationships with the professional world. These are complementary skills to the technical skills and they are necessary to manage and deal with different aspects of work, to be creative or reactive when dealing with problems or unexpected events.
