

NOTICE OF CALL FOR SCIENCE DEGREE INCENTIVES A.Y. 2022/2023

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PREAMBLE

In order to support enrolments in classes of national or EU interest and in implementation of Ministerial Decree no. 289/2021 (Annex 3 TABLE 7 ter - ASSIGNMENT OF YOUNG PEOPLE FUND 2021) for the Degree classes in the scientific-technological area, the University of Padua assigns incentives to students enrolled in particular courses of study.

1. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

For the academic year 2022/2023, specific incentives are envisaged for students enrolled in courses of study belonging to the following classes:

Students will be selected by the University on the basis of the following requirements:

1. **regular enrolment** in the **second and third year** of the above-mentioned study courses in the 2022/23 academic year, completed by 31 October 2022;
2. **merit**, based on the relevant coefficient accrued as at 10 August 2022;
3. **economic condition** indicated by the ISEE value.

The incentive consists of exemption or semi-exemption from contributions, **up to a maximum amount of 1,000.00 Euro**, which will be allocated according to the position in the ranking list and until the resources available last.

2. CRITERIA FOR THE FORMULATION OF THE RANKING

The ranking will take into account in varying proportions:

- merit (measured by the merit coefficient as defined in the call for applications for the a.y. 2022/2023 regional scholarship);
- economic situation (measured by the ISEE for benefits for the Right to University Education, acquired by the University through the entry of the Application for Benefits for the a.y. 2022/23 in Uniweb).

The maximum score achievable by students is set at 100 points.

A maximum of 70 points are awarded for **scholastic merit** and the assignment of points is as follows:

Merit coefficient	Score
Greater than 70	70
Between 60 - 70	60
Between 50 - 60	50
Between 40 - 50	40
Between 30 - 40	30
Between 20 - 30	20
Between 10 - 20	10
Less than 10	0

A maximum of 30 points are awarded for **economic situation** and the assignment of points is as follows:

ISEE	Score
Greater than euro 60,000.00	0
Between euro 50,000.00 - 60,000.00	5
Between euro 40,000.00 - 50,000.00	10
Between euro 30,000.00 - 40,000.00	15
Between euro 20,000.00 - 30,000.00	20
Between euro 10,000.00 - 20,000.00	25
Less than euro 10,000.00	30

The total score is the sum of the points awarded for merit and the points awarded for economic situation, as defined above. In the event of a tied total score, preference will be given to the individual merit coefficient.

The ranking will be drawn up in descending order of total score and will be published **by 30 November 2022** in the dedicated section of the page: www.unipd.it/esoneri-studenti.

3. DELIVERY METHOD

The application of the exemption or semi-exemption will be visible in Uniweb from December 2022 and will be applied on the second and third instalments.

If a credit condition arises for having paid instalments in full before applying this exemption, the University will automatically proceed with the reimbursement.

Reimbursements will be credited exclusively to the bank details (IBAN) of the student's current account (held individually or jointly), or prepaid card, which must be entered by the student in the Uniweb reserved area, under the heading "Teaching – Personal data – Change of refund data" (bank details of third parties, including parents, cannot be accepted).+

If the student resides abroad (outside Italy), he/she must specify his/her domicile in Italy in the UNIWEB reserved area, under "Teaching – Personal data – Change of domicile data"; otherwise it will be impossible to proceed with the reimbursement.

4. PERSON IN CHARGE OF THE PROCEDURE AND PROCESSING DATA

Pursuant to article 4 of Italian Law no. 241 of 7 August 1990 (*Nuove norme in materia di procedimento amministrativo e di diritto di accesso ai documenti amministrativi*, New rules on administrative procedures and on the right of access to administrative documents) and subsequent amendments, the Director of the Student Services Office, Alessandra Biscaro, will be appointed as the Person in Charge of the Administrative Procedure.

Candidates may exercise their right of access to the application documents according to the provisions of *Decreto del Presidente della Repubblica* (Italian Presidential Decree) no. 184 of 12 April 2006 (*Regolamento recante disciplina in materia di accesso ai documenti amministrativi in conformità al capo V della Legge 241/90*, Regulation governing access to administrative documents pursuant to Chapter V of Italian Law 241/90).

Personal data collected for the purposes set out in this notice is processed in compliance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) no. 679 of 27 April 2016 (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR).
