Scores will be rounded to two decimal places.

## First call for applications:

1 - Students enrolled from the second year onwards: (CM-C - CM-Min) / (CM-Max - CMMin) * $x$
where: CM-C is the candidate's coefficient of merit; CM-Max is the maximum Coefficient of Merit recorded among all candidates enrolled from the second year onwards; CM-Min is the minimum Coefficient of Merit recorded among all candidates enrolled from the second year onwards.

2 - First year L2/LM5/LM6 students with an Italian diploma and 0 credits: (TEST-C -TEST-Min) / (TEST-Max - TEST-Min) * $x$
where: TEST-C is the candidate's admission score; TEST-Min is the lowest admission score and TEST-Max is the highest score recorded among all enrolled first-year L2, LM5 and LM6 candidates. The scores of the various admission tests will be reported on a scale of 100. In the event of the absence of an admission score, the high school mark will be taken into account.

3 - First year L2/LM5/LM6/LM students with an International qualification: (Score-C -Score-Min) / (Score-Max - Score-Min) * x
where: Score-C is the candidate's admission score, Score-Min and Score-Max are respectively the lowest and highest admission score recorded among all candidates enrolled with this profile.

4 - First year LM students or PhD students graduated in Italy: (Grade-C - Grade-Min) / (Grade-Max - Grade-Min) * x
where: Grade-C is the degree mark obtained in the course of study considered for the candidate's admission, Grade-Min and Grade-Max are respectively the lowest and highest degree marks recorded among all candidates enrolled with this profile. A grade of 110 cum laude is counted as 111..

## Annex 1

The certificates accepted are those recognised by the University Language Centre (https://cla.unipd.it/test-linguistici/certificazioni/), unless otherwise indicated in the call for applications for each destination. The main types of certificates are listed below.

For all languages, mother-tongue students are recognised a C2 level. Native speakers are considered to be students who have attended at least the entire secondary school cycle and obtained the relative diploma (corresponding to the DIPLOMA DI MATURITA') in a country in which the language being assessed is considered an official language.

Degree courses held entirely in a foreign language (English or other) will be considered equivalent to a certified level B2 (if a vehicular language) and C1 in the case of an official language.

Secondary school courses completed at international schools in Italy or abroad (e.g. International Baccalaureate - IB Diploma Programme) or within the framework of educational cooperation between ministries (e.g. ESABAC) are considered equivalent to a certified B2.

Curricular language examinations passed as part of a degree course will also be considered valid, with the stated level. In the absence of any indication, they will be considered equivalent to an A2 level. For more details on the levels attributed to UNIPD examinations by the various Departments, please refer to Annex 2.

TALs and other tests conducted by the Centro Linguistico di Ateneo (CLA) will be considered on the basis of the declared level.
