

THiMe - Temporalities, Histories and Methods of Philosophy. Re-thinking the Canon of History of Philosophy and Political Thought

In traditional philosophy education, the focus has long been on a narrow, Western-centric perspective. This approach often excludes diverse philosophical traditions and overlooks alternative histories of thought. Supported by the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) programme, the THiMe project aims to change this by rethinking how we study the History of Philosophy. By blending methodologies from different philosophers like Gueroult, Deleuze, Strauss, and Koselleck, THiMe seeks to uncover overlooked philosophical ideas and challenge the limitations of the established canon. This initiative aims to create a more inclusive and comprehensive methodology for exploring philosophical and political thought, fostering new perspectives that could lead to societal transformation.
