What are the main features of your double degree program?

The Padua-Tsinghua double degree program requires students to be enrolled as full-time students at both Universities, spending at least 16 months of physical mobility at the host university (Tsinghua University). On this basis, students are required to complete all compulsory coursework for the

chosen master degree program at the host University (Tsinghua University), and prepare a final thesis that is specific to the guidelines of the host institution. Meanwhile, the students are also required to conduct and present a second master thesis upon return to the University of Padua in fulfilment of the degree awarded at UNIPD.

What is the added value in participating in these kind of programs (academic and private)?

The Padua-Tsinghua dual degree program tested my skills in various dimensions and provided me with additional skills relevant for both professional and personal growth. Time management, self-motivation, and organisation were key. I was introduced to a more complex style of conducting research that required working independently, and on most occasions while also paying attention to details, no matter how small they might be.
