ICPU Partnership

- The ICPU <u>partnership</u> is a collaborative project organized by three internationally renowned Universities:
 - the University of Padua (Italy)
 - the University of Sydney (Australia)
 - the University of Lausanne (Switzerland);
- Edition 2025 will be hosted by the University of Sydney;
- The project class will be made up of a mix of 75 students from the three universities (25 from each university);
- External partners (industries, community, organizations, other stakeholders) will also be involved throughout the project

ICPU in a nutshell

- ➤ The project includes a 6 CFU ad-hoc teaching course
- Students will be asked to respond to an operational question and/or case study
- The activity will be led by academics and industry leaders with high-level expertise
- Students will be divided into interdisciplinary groups of 5-10 members



GOALS:

- To promote the development of soft skills (e.g. teamwork, problem-solving approach, etc.)
- To foster the connection with companies and the business world
- To develop the ability to relate and collaborate between students from different fields of study and backgrounds



ICPU Learning Outcomes

At the end of the programme, students will be able to:

- LO1. Demonstrate critical awareness of, and apply, disciplinary knowledge, skills, and personal attributes to address complex real-world problems
- LO2. Assess and integrate diverse stakeholder perspectives to generate innovative insights into complex problems
- LO3. Purposefully select and apply complex problem-solving approaches and methods
- LO4. Communicate novel ideas effectively and persuasively in professional settings using relevant media
- LO5. Demonstrate professionalism (proficiency, adaptivity, and proactivity) in collaborative project work



ICPU Financial support

Maximum contribution of €1,500 managed on a mission basis

- based on the coverage of the costs actually incurred and duly documented
 - if higher than the contribution, the excess part of the mission cost will be borne by the individual student;
 - if lower, the reimbursement of the mission cost will be 0 limited to the expense incurred
 - -> only in case of actual participation and achievement of the expected educational results.

-> to take out a travel insurance policy providing for reimbursement in the event of cancellation it is strongly recommended

- > Double / joint degree students
- First year bachelor students

- 1. Language certificate
- 2. Transcript of records/Diploma supplement
- 3. Motivational video (max 2 min)
- 4. Further useful documents



ICPU Language requirements

<u>English proficiency at a B2 level or higher</u> (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).

Please check the eligible certificates on the <u>Programme sheet</u>: <u>https://www.unipd.it/global-intensives</u>

Language certificates must be taken within the <u>past 2 years</u> and be valid for the entire duration of the programme. All the abovementioned conditions must be met at application date.

<u>University Language Centre (CLA) is accredited for IELTS</u> certifications.

If you take the IELTS test at CLA, you can apply by submitting the IELTS session reservation confirmation instead of the language certificate. IELTS results will be sent by CLA directly to the Projects & Mobility Office and will be used for selection purposes.
