Overall description	The collaboration between Texas State University (TXST) and the University of Padua offers a unique opportunity for academic and cultural exchange through the Texas State Summer Hubs @ UNIPD . As part of this initiative, between May and June 2025, students and teachers from the American university will take part in educational activities at our university, contributing to the enrichment of our educational offerings and promoting the exchange of knowledge and experiences between the two institutions. Starting this year, students enrolled in the Bachelor's Degree in Human Movement Sciences will also have the opportunity to choose and participate in one of the two courses taught in English by TXST professors, joining their future fellow American students in a shared learning experience.
Contents	The programme is divided into several teaching modules conducted simultaneously. Specifically, the Fitness Assessment and programming in Clinical exercise science module (ESS 4319 - Prof. John Farrell) provides students with the opportunity to acquire knowledge and skills in exercise assessment and prescription for clinical populations, while also gaining a deeper understanding of patient care and rehabilitation management in a clinical setting. During the programme, students are required to attend at least 70% of classes, complete assignments on time, and actively participate in the learning activities.
