

MOBILITY GRANT AMOUNTS FOR THE 2025/26 A.Y.

For 2025/26 Erasmus+ mobilities the amounts are allocated as follows:

- **€400.00 monthly** (meaning 30 days) for: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Ireland, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Norway, The Netherlands, Sweden, United Kingdom
- **€350.00 monthly** (meaning 30 days) for: Bulgaria, Cyprus, Croatia, Estonia, Greece, Latvia, Lithuania, North Macedonia, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Czech Republic, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Hungary, Turkey
- **€700.00 monthly** (meaning 30 days) for destinations beyond Europe

For the **2025/26 academic year**, students may be funded through **two different Erasmus+ calls: call 2024 or call 2025**.

Regardless of the funding call, **all students going to the same destination country will receive the same monthly grant**.

ATTENTION!

The Grant Agreement only refers to the **Erasmus+ funds** (EU funds). Students funded under the **call 2024** will see a slightly lower monthly amount (50€ less per month) stated in their Grant Agreement compared to those funded under the call 2025. However, **this difference will be automatically covered by University funds**, ensuring that all students receive the same overall monthly grant.

This supplement is not included in the Grant Agreement, as the Agreement only reflects EU contributions. In any case, no action is required on the part of the student: the €50 supplement will be paid automatically at the same time as the Erasmus+ grant payment.

Another difference between call 2024 and call 2025 concerns the **travel costs reimbursement**: in the call 2024 this item is not ticked, as travel is not funded by European funds but rather by University funds; in call 2025 travel costs are funded by Erasmus+ European funds and is therefore included in the Grant Agreement.

This, too, is a **purely formal difference**: all students going to the same destination will receive the same amount for travel cost reimbursement, regardless of the funding call.
