

Additional funding to the Erasmus+ for studies beyond Europe Grant

a) Contribution to travel costs

Students participating in the Erasmus+ for studies beyond Europe call will receive a contribution to the travel costs on a lump-sum basis. The amounts vary based on the following “kilometre bands” defined by the European Commission

a1) mobility in the a.y. 2018/2019 second semester only

Distance band (km)	Amount
Between 100 and 499 km	€180,00 per participant
Between 500 and 1999 km	€275,00 per participant
Between 2000 and 2999 km	€360,00 per participant
Between 3000 and 3999 km	€530,00 per participant
Between 4000 and 7999 km	€820,00 per participant
Over 8000 km	€1.100,00 per participant

A2) mobility in the a.y. 2019/2020

Distance band (km)	Amount
Between 0 and 99 km	€20,00 per participant
Between 100 and 499 km	€180,00 per participant
Between 500 and 1999 km	€275,00 per participant
Between 2000 and 2999 km	€360,00 per participant
Between 3000 and 3999 km	€530,00 per participant
Between 4000 and 7999 km	€820,00 per participant
Over 8000 km	€1.100,00 per participant

Nota bene: Travel expenses are calculated on the basis of the distance between the University of Padova and the Receiving Institution. The distance of a one-way travel must be used to calculate the amount of the EU grant that will support the round trip.

b) Additional funding based on merit and annual income (ISEE/ISEU)

The University of Padova has increased the additional funding for mobility, based on merit (defined in the list of students for the regional study scholarship) and the ISEE/ISEU declaration.

In order to be able to benefit from the additional funding, all **students with an ISSE/ISEU less than €50,000**, must submit the ISEE/ISEU declaration on Uniweb, **between 9th and 22nd July 2019** following the procedures defined by the Student Service Office.

Students from the second-year *fuori corso*¹ will not receive any additional funding..

The amounts of the additional funding are defined as follows:

Additional funding based on the annual income only (ISEE/ISEU):

4th GROUP ISEE from 13.001,00 to 21.000,00	€ 400,00
5th GROUP ISEE from 21.001,00 to 26.000,00	€ 350,00
6th GROUP ISEE from 26.001,00 to 30.000,00	€ 300,00
7th GROUP ISEE from 30.001,00 to 40.000,00	€ 200,00
8th GROUP ISEE from 40.001,00 to 50.000,00	€ 150,00
