SCHOOL OF HUMAN AND SOCIAL SCIENCES AND CULTURAL HERITAGE – UNIVERSITY OF PADOVA SELECTION CRITERIA FOR ERASMUS+ STUDY AND SEMP CANDIDATES A.Y. 2022/2023

ADMISSION To be admitted to the above-mentioned student mobility programs, the School of Human and Social Sciences and Cultural Heritage has adopted the guidelines provided in the Erasmus+ Study and SEMP University Calls regarding the admission requirements, the number of credits that students must have registered in order to apply, and the application procedures.

SELECTION

Each candidate can choose up to **2** different destinations by assigning a priority order (1, 2,): the allocation of available scholarships takes place considering the priority.

The list of successful and eligible candidates takes into consideration the priority of choice of the destination.

The academic coordinator (responsabile di flusso) is in charge of the selection of the candidates.

For the Arqus destinations candidates are selected by the Erasmus coordinators of their Departments.

The base score is the weighted average of the grades correctly recorded in Uniweb within the deadline set in the Call.

If the academic coordinator (or the Department Erasmus coordinator for the Arqus destinations) considers the candidate eligible for the destination chosen he/she will assign an additional score between 0 and 20 points considering the following criteria:

- Evaluation of the academic career;
- Content Attachment 1/1 a (mandatory attachment);
- Motivation letter (mandatory attachment);
- Language competence (to be self-certified when applying in Uniweb).

Should the candidate be considered non-eligible for the destination chosen the coordinator will assign -20.

INTERVIEW Should a compulsory interview with the academic coordinator be required to be admitted to the selection process (if an interview is compulsory this is clearly indicated in the Notes column in the destinations' file), the interview must be held before submitting the application on Uniweb. The candidate must contact the academic coordinator in advance to schedule the interview. The academic coordinator can assign non-eligibility to candidates who have not taken the interview.

Eligible candidates that have not been selected will remain on the ranking list for both destinations chosen and will be contacted in the case of places becoming available after the withdrawal of selected candidates; candidates selected for one destination will be automatically excluded from the ranking list of the other destination chosen.
