Since 2007 he has been an **expert and Vice Chair, on behalf of the European Commission, within** the evaluation exercise of the **Marie Sklodowska Curie Actions**, both in FP7 and in Horizon 2020 (Actions Individual Fellowships, Innovative Training Networks, Co-funding of regional, national and international Programmes). From 2016 he also acts as evaluator and vice-chair within evaluation processes related to Horizon 2020 "Social challenge 6" (inclusive societies) and "Science With And For Society".

From December 2012 to February 2014 he was Head of Technology Transfer Office (TTO) at the Politecnico of Milano. From March 2014 to June 2016, he was in charge of the Technical Directorate "Promotion and valorisation of Research" at OGS (*Istituto Nazionale di Oceanografia e Geofisica Sperimentale* - National Institute of Oceanography and Experimental Geophysics). Currently he works at the Sapienza University of Rome, as Head of Fund Raising Office, where he deals with the promotion and support of national and international research, as well as with the support for drafting research agreements of the Sapienza with public and private institutions.
