COMMON DATES AND DEADLINES

- Start of the academic year: Wednesday 1 October 2025
- Start of teaching activities: Monday 29 September 2025

The competent teaching structures, by giving notice through their website by Tuesday 26 August 2025, can bring forward the start of teaching activities to Monday 22 September 2025.

The competent teaching structures, by giving **notice** through their website **by Tuesday 16 September 2025**, may **postpone** the start and end of teaching activities.

If required by the admission procedures to degree programmes with limited access at national level, the teaching activities of these degree programmes may begin after Monday 29 September 2025.

The start of the lessons will be announced through the website of the educational structures concerned.

ENROLMENT AND ENROLMENT IN YEARS SUBSEQUENT TO THE FIRST

The dates of enrolment in the **first year** of the Degree Programmes (enrolments) are determined through the relevant **Admission Notices**.

Enrolment in **years subsequent** to the first takes place by **Tuesday 30 September 2025** with the payment of the **first instalment** of fees.

Students who graduate by Saturday 13 December 2025 are exempt from paying the first instalment.

FINAL EXAMS

In each of the three periods it is mandatory to provide for at least one session, unless otherwise provided by the Ministry.

Degree Programmes pursuant to Ministerial Decree 509/99 and 270/04

- First period from Monday 9 March 2026 to Friday 24 April 2026
- Second period from Monday 22 June 2026 to Saturday 25 July 2026
- Third period A+B from Monday 31 August 2026 to Saturday 12 December 2026

Degree Programmes prior to Ministerial Decree 509/99

- Extraordinary Session a.y. 2024/25 from Monday 9 March 2026 to Friday 24 April 2026
- Summer session from Monday 22 June 2026 to Saturday 25 July 2026
- Autumn session from Monday 31 August 2026 to Saturday 12 December 2026

Period for submitting the application for admission to the final examination

Students who are up to date with the payment of fees can submit the application for admission to the final exam by the following dates:

FIRST TERM - GRADUATION FROM MONDAY, MARCH 9, 2026 TO FRIDAY, APRIL 24, 2026

- Graduation application deadline: from Monday 12 January 2026 to Tuesday 10 February 2026
- Deadline for taking exams: 15 days before the start of the graduation session
- Payment of fees: first and second instalments 2025/26

SECOND PERIOD: GRADUATIONS FROM MONDAY 22 JUNE 2026 TO SATURDAY 25 JULY 2026

- Graduation application deadline: from Monday 20 April 2026 to Tuesday 19 May 2026
- Deadline for taking exams: 15 days before the start of the graduation session
- Payment of fees: first, second and third instalments 2025/26

THIRD PERIOD A: GRADUATIONS FROM MONDAY 31 AUGUST 2026 TO SATURDAY 17 OCTOBER 2026

- Graduation application deadline: from Monday 15 June 2026 to Tuesday 14 July 2026
- Deadline for taking exams: 15 days before the start of the graduation session
- Payment of fees: first, second and third instalments 2025/26

THIRD PERIOD B: GRADUATIONS FROM MONDAY 9 NOVEMBER 2026 TO SATURDAY 12 DECEMBER 2026

- Graduation application deadline: from Monday 31 August 2026 to Tuesday 13 October 2026
- Deadline for taking exams: 15 days before the start of the graduation session
- Payment of fees: first, second and third instalments 2025/26

The graduation sessions and the deadlines for submitting the graduation application for the Degree Courses in the Health Professions are set by the competent teaching structures, after obtaining the ministerial indications.

Please note

- The dates of the individual graduation sessions must be established and communicated by the competent teaching structures to the Student Careers Office at least 30 days before the date of proclamation.
- Students enrolled in a Bachelor's Degree Course in the Health Professions (Classes 1-4SNT), who obtain their degree in a graduation session starting by Thursday 30 April 2026 and who have acquired all certificates of attendance by September 2025, are exempt from paying the first instalment of fees for the academic year 2025/2026.
- Students enrolled in the last year of a degree programme with a system prior to Ministerial Decree 509/99 who graduate by Thursday 30 April 2026 are exempt from paying the first instalment of fees for the academic year 2025/2026.
- To be admitted to the final examination, it is mandatory to make all payments due within fifteen days prior to the date of the graduation session (Student Career Regulations, art. 24).

Periods of lessons and assessments

ACTIVITY OVER QUARTERS

Each course of study must provide **at least 9 weeks** of actual teaching activity within the periods indicated. The formal formalities of recording the progress assessments for the courses of study according to Ministerial Decrees 509/99 and 270/04 may begin before the start of the two official exam sessions, at the end of the 9 weeks of frontal activity.

FIRST TRIMESTER

- Teaching: from Monday 29 September 2025 to Saturday 29 November 2025
- Assessment of progress: from Monday 1 December 2025 to Saturday 20 December 2025

SECOND TRIMESTER

- Teaching: from Wednesday 7 January 2026 to Saturday 14 March 2026
- Assessment of progress: from Monday 16 March 2026 to Thursday 2 April 2026

THIRD TRIMESTER

- Teaching: from Wednesday 8 April 2026 to Friday 12 June 2026
- Assessment of progress: from Monday 15 June 2026 to Saturday 18 July 2026

ACTIVITIES ON SEMESTERS

Each course of study must provide at least 12 weeks of actual teaching activity within the periods indicated. The formal formalities of recording the progress assessments for the courses of study according to Ministerial Decrees 509/99 and 270/04 may begin before the start of the two official exam sessions, at the end of the 12 weeks of face-to-face activity.

FIRST SEMESTER

- Teaching: from Monday 29 September 2025 to Saturday 17 January 2026
- Assessment of progress: from Monday 19 January 2026 to Saturday 21 February 2026

SECOND SEMESTER

- Teaching: from Monday 23 February 2026 to Friday 12 June 2026
- Assessment of progress: from Monday 15 June 2026 to Saturday 18 July 2026

RETRIEVAL

Assessment of progress: from Wednesday 19 August 2026 to Saturday 19 September 2026

SESSION FOR GRADUATING STUDENTS BY 12 DECEMBER 2026

Assessment of progress: from Thursday 1 October 2026 to Saturday 21 November 2026

For the Degree Courses of the Health Professions, the teaching activities and the assessment of progress are planned, allowing the carrying out of professionalizing internships in compliance with EU regulations and ministerial indications.

The lessons of the first year of the degree programmes with limited access at national level begin after the enrolment of the candidates, based on the date of the admission test set by Ministerial Decree.

- Assessment of progress: from Monday 15 June 2026 to Saturday 18 July 2026

RETRIEVAL

Assessment of progress: from Wednesday 19 August 2026 to Saturday 19 September 2026

SESSION FOR GRADUATING STUDENTS BY 12 DECEMBER 2026

Assessment of progress: from Thursday 1 October 2026 to Saturday 21 November 2026

Please note

- The competent teaching structures may authorise teachers to open extraordinary sessions outside the periods established above, to students who are not on track with the regulations in force prior to Ministerial Decree 509/99 and to repeating students with Ministerial Decree 509/99 and 270/04, provided that this does not interfere with normal teaching activities
- For courses of study activated in inter-university mode with foreign universities (issue of double degree or joint degree), the competent teaching structures may provide for extraordinary sessions for assessment and final examinations outside the periods established above.
- The graduation sessions and the deadlines for submitting the graduation application for the degree courses in the health professions are set by the competent teaching structures, after obtaining the ministerial indications, taking into account the needs of the University's teaching planning.
