



MOBILITY RULE **according to MSCA Individual Fellowship Guide For Applicants:**

For Standard European Fellowships (ST) the researcher must not have resided or carried out his/her main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the beneficiary for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately before the call deadline, unless as part of a procedure for obtaining refugee status under the Geneva Convention.

Compulsory national service and/or short stays such as holidays are not taken into account.

In the Career Restart Panel (CAR), Reintegration Panel (RI), or Society & Enterprise Panel (SE), the researcher must not have resided or carried out the main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the beneficiary for more than 36 months in the 5 years immediately before the call deadline.

In the Global Fellowships (GF) the researcher must not have resided or carried out the main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the TC **partner organisation** where the initial outgoing phase takes place for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately before the call deadline, unless as part of a procedure for obtaining refugee status under the Geneva Convention.

Compulsory national service and/or short stays such as holidays are not taken into account.
