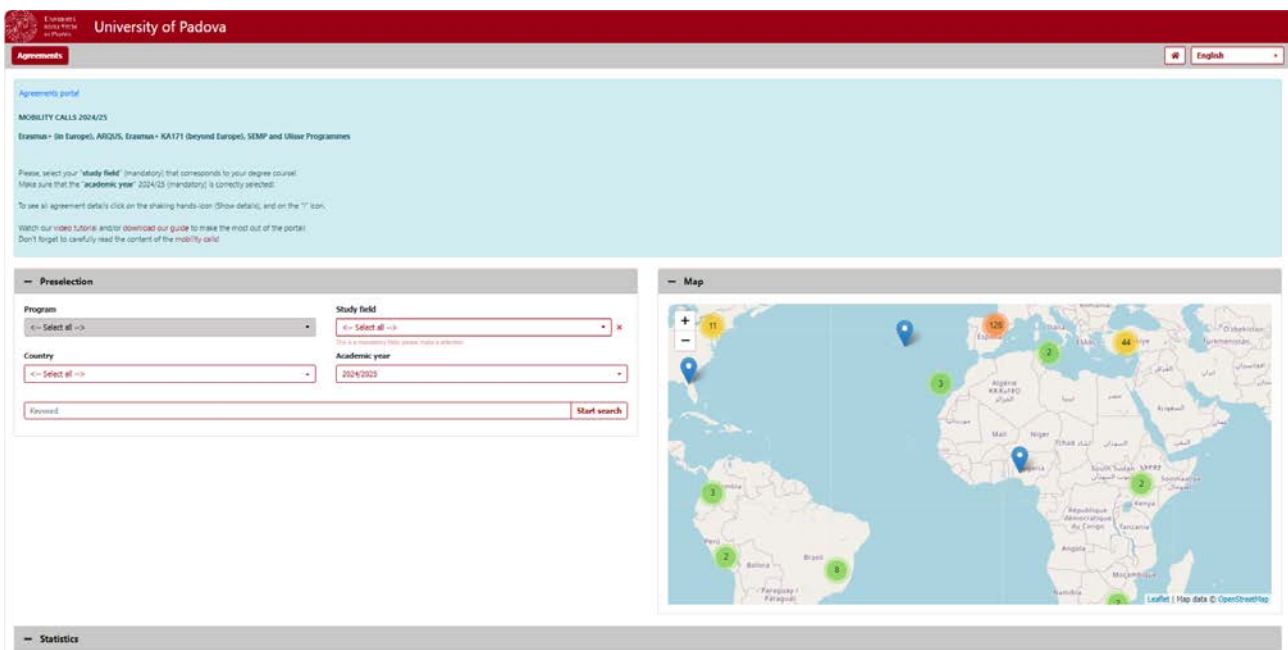


The Student Mobility Agreements Portal

STEP 1 - Link to access the portal

To view the agreements available for the mobility for studies calls, you need to log on to the portal at the link: www.unipd.it/mobility-agreements (Figure 1).

STEP 2 - Setting the criteria for selecting agreements

It is then **mandatory to select the degree course** from the '**Study field**' drop-down menu. If you are enrolled in the third year of a Bachelor's degree course and wish to spend your mobility in a Master's degree course, you need

to filter the agreements with the code of the Master's degree course you intend to enrol in.

All other filters ('**Program**' and '**Country**') are optional (**Figure 2**). The portal provides the agreements of all mobility programmes for the academic year shown under '**Academic Year**': Ulisse, SEMP, Erasmus beyond Europe (KA171), Erasmus in Europe and Arqus. Please, make sure that the academic year in which the mobility will take place is selected.

Degree course code: where to find it?

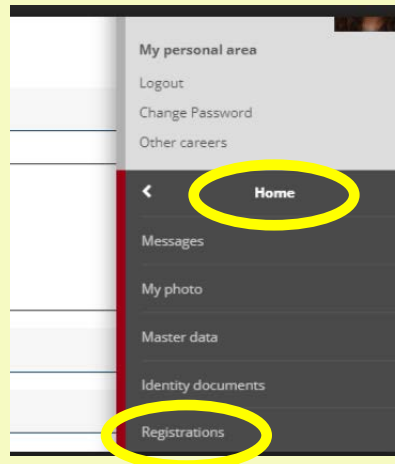


Figure 4 - *Dettaglio Iscrizione, Corso di studio and code*

To avoid selection errors, it is recommended that you check the code of your degree course, available on Uniweb, in your personal profile (Home > Registrations, under "Corso di studio") (**Figures 3 and 4**).

Figure 3 – Uniweb, Home>Registrations

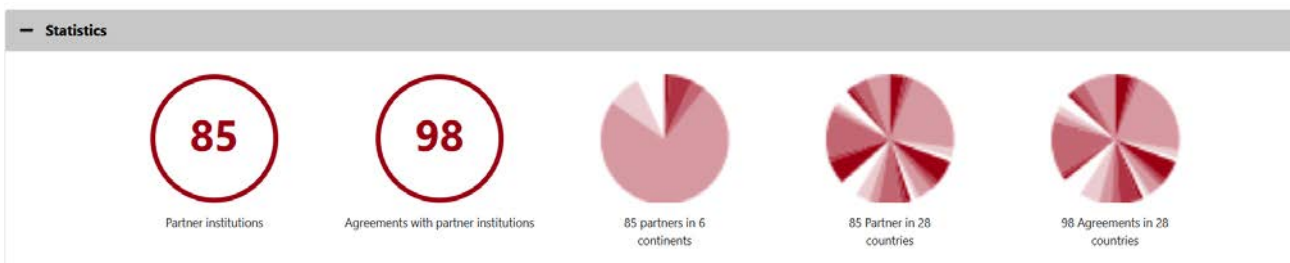

Figure 8 – List of selected agreements



Next to the name of the institution, by clicking on the + or – icon you can display or hide the main information of the partner institution, namely: name of the institution, Erasmus code and country.

STEP3 - Accessing data and information of each agreement

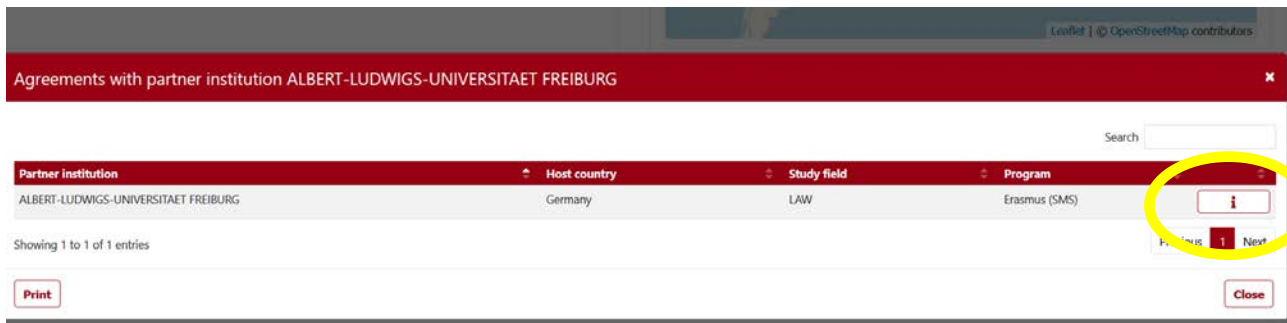
To access the specific information for each agreement, please click:

- 1) on the 'Show details' icon on the right, under the column 'Agreements'.


Figure 9 – Agreements per partner Institution

- 2) then, from the "*Agreements with partner institution ...*" box, click on the **'i' icon**. In some cases, several agreements may be available for one institution. Please read the information sheets carefully in order to understand the differences (e.g. for the Ulisse programme, some agreements provide funding, others are zero grant, for the Erasmus programme some agreements may differ even only in terms of the Departmental Coordinator, etc.) (**Figure 9**).

This will open the tab with all the information about the agreement. By clicking on '**Print**' (bottom left) you can download the PDF with all the information about the agreement (**Figure 10**).

For the **second call**, you can always view the full list of agreements for your course of study. However, by clicking on the "i" icon, you will not be able to access the data of agreements that are no longer available; you will only be able to enter the page dedicated to the data of agreements with available places.

In the '**Bilateral Agreement data**' section (left-hand side) you will find all the main information (e.g. Erasmus code, teacher responsible for the flow, isced/area of study) to be noted down in order to correctly select the destination in Uniweb (**Figure 11**):

- Under the '**Number**' headings, the number of total places and months stipulated in the agreement, allocated at the first call and vacant for the second call, are indicated. In the example, two places are still available.


The total number of months indicated in the portal for each agreement must be divided by the number of available places. The number of months thus calculated for each student corresponds to the maximum

duration that can be financed (in the example 15 months are to be divided by 3 places, so each student will have 5 months of mobility).

- To find out which **study cycle**¹ the agreement is available for, it is necessary to check the corresponding number of places available. If 0 places are available for a study cycle, this means that the agreement does not foresee mobility for this level. The number of places reported for each level of study refers to the total number of places available (in the example, the agreement with SF HELSINK01 allows mobility, for a maximum of 3 places, for the second and third cycle, not for the first)
- the Erasmus code of the partner Institution (e.g. SF HELSINK01)
- The ISCED code of the agreement, i.e. the area of study of the agreement (e.g. 0611 - Computer use)
- The name of the Academic Coordinator (e.g. Prof. Mauro Conti)
- If relevant, the Campus/Faculty at the partner institution

¹ The study cycles are as follows: first-cycle degree courses (*First cycle/Bachelor/Undergraduate/Bachelor*), second-cycle degree courses (*Second cycle/Master/Postgraduate*), and third-cycle PhD/Doctoral courses (*Third cycle/Phd/Doctoral*)

The **Information of Agreement** section (right-hand side) displays all additional information related to the agreement (**Figures 12 and 13**), including:

- **Additional requirements:** if available, very important notes concerning the agreement are specified



- **Useful links:** if available, useful links to the partner institution's website (e.g. course catalogue, application form, language requirements...) are given.


