You will be asked to enter the following data:

SECTION 3 – ABOUT YOUR FELLOWSHIP

Please enter the following data:

- h) Type of Grant** (*choose between “European Fellowship” and “Global Fellowship”*)

- *European Postdoctoral Fellowships* are open to researchers of any nationality who wish to engage in R&I projects at the University of Padua. They can last between 12 and 24 months.

- *Global Postdoctoral Fellowships* are open to European nationals or long-term residents¹ who wish to engage in R&I projects with organizations outside EU Member States and Horizon Europe Associated Countries. These fellowships require an outgoing phase of max. 24 months in a non-associated Third Country and a mandatory 12-month return phase to a Host Department at the University of Padua.

i) *Proposed MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF) PROJECT TITLE*

The project title is not final and may be amended.

j) *Proposed MSCA- PF PROJECT ACRONYM*

The Acronym is a word formed by abbreviating and by combining certain letters of the title of your project. The acronym is provisional and may be amended eventually.

k) *Estimated duration of the project* (number of months)

- *European Fellowships*: the standard duration of these fellowships must be between 12 and 24 months;
- *Global Fellowships*: these fellowships require an outgoing phase of minimum 12 and maximum 24 months in a non-associated Third Country and a mandatory 12-month return phase to the University of Padua.

m) *Department at Unipd that will host the research*

n) *Name of the Partner Institution in a Third Country*

For Global Fellowships only, if you are applying for a European Fellowship, please write "N.A."

o) *MSCA Scientific Panels*

In Postdoctoral Fellowships, proposals will be evaluated by one of eight 'main evaluation panels'. Please choose one among: Chemistry (CHE), Social Sciences and Humanities (SOC), Economic Sciences (ECO), Information Science and Engineering (ENG), Environment and Geosciences (ENV), Life Sciences (LIF), Mathematics (MAT), Physics (PHY).

SECTION 4 – ELIGIBILITY CHECK

Research experience:

¹ Long-term residence means a period of legal and continuous residence within EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Countries of at least five consecutive years.

At the call deadline, researchers must have a maximum of 8 year full-time equivalent experience in research, measured from the date of the doctoral degree. Years of experience outside research and career breaks will not count towards the amount of research experience.

Mobility rule:

Recruited researchers must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in Italy (for European Postdoctoral Fellowships), or the host organization for the outgoing phase (for Global Postdoctoral Fellowships) for more than 12 months in the 36 months immediately before the call deadline.

For researchers wishing to reintegrate from a third country, there must be a direct mobility to an EU Member State or Horizon Europe Associated Country. More information on the European Commission Funding & Tender opportunities portal.

p) Date of PhD Award

Fellows must be postdoctoral researchers at the date of the call deadline, i.e. in a possession of a doctoral degree². Applicants who have successfully defended their doctoral thesis but who have not yet formally been awarded the doctoral degree will also be considered as postdoctoral researchers and will be considered eligible to apply.

q) Career breaks (starting from the date of PhD award)

Please LIST the DATES of any career breaks (FROM dd/mm/yyyy -TO dd/mm/yyyy) and the REASON thereof (paternity/maternity leave, unemployment....).

E.g.

1. 13/07/2019 - 12/07/2020 for maternity leave;
2. 02/03/2022 – 03/03/2023 unemployed.

r) Experience outside research (starting from the date of PhD award)

Please LIST the dates of any Experience outside research (FROM dd/mm/yyyy -TO dd/mm/yyyy) and the REASON thereof (work as a teacher, ...).

² A medical doctor degree will be accepted only when it corresponds to a doctoral degree or if the researcher can demonstrate his/her appointment in a position that requires doctoral equivalency (e.g. professorship appointment). Medical doctor degrees corresponding to basic medical training as defined in Annex V of Directive 2005/36/EC will not be considered a doctoral degree.

- t) **Country (ies) in which you have legally resided and/or had your main activity** (work, studies, etc) **during the last 5 years** (from 9 Sept 2021 to 9 Sept 2026, the whole period, according to the mobility rule of MSCA-PF)
