

CREDIT CONVERSION TABLE – INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY OUTSIDE THE EU

The lack of a universal credit system often creates difficulties in the evaluation and recognition of foreign activities carried out during a period of international mobility in countries that do not apply the ECTS system. The following table is intended as an indicative, non-prescriptive tool to facilitate both students and teaching staff in the compilation and evaluation of Learning Agreements, and subsequent recognition, as well as to promote greater consistency and fairness of treatment. The information contained in any official documentation produced by the partner (e.g. Transcript of Records) or in official documents drawn up by our University (e.g. specific resolutions, addenda to bilateral agreements, etc.) take precedence over the indications presented below.
