

TYPES OF SELF-CERTIFICATION:

Within the meaning of art. 40 of Italian Presidential Decree DPR no. 445/2000 as amended by art. 15 of Lay no. 183 dated 12 November 2011, starting from 1 January 2012 Public administration and public service providers can no longer request or accept certificates issued by other public offices from private individuals.

Therefore, information on status, personal qualities and facts must be provided in a statement in lieu of certificate (art. 46 of DPR no. 445/2000) or of affidavit (art. 47 of DPR no. 445/2000).

Public administration and public service providers not accepting self-certifications are in **breach of official** duty.

For enrolled students:

- Insurance
- Self-certification of enrolment and transcript of records
- Self-certification of tuition fees per calendar year (current and previous year).

For graduates:

- Self-certification of academic qualification and transcript of records
- Self-certification of tuition fees per calendar year (current and previous year).
