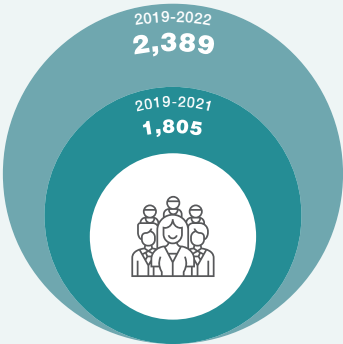

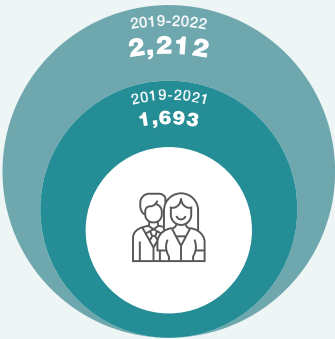

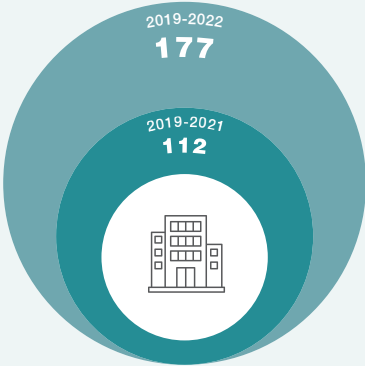
TOTAL DONORS FROM 2022



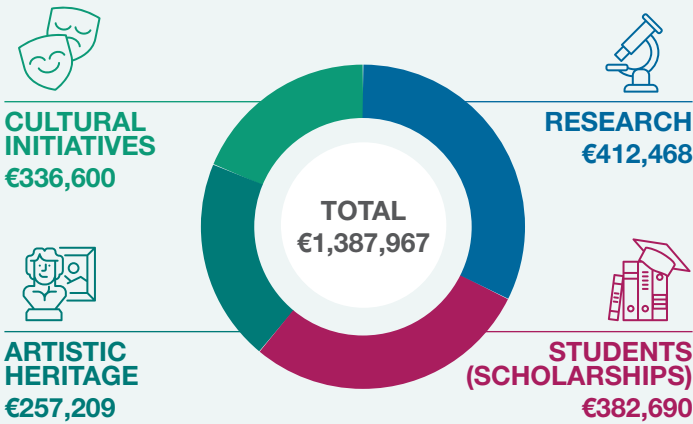

BEAT the BEAT: research in support of the non-profit La Stella di Lorenzo Association

The collaboration of the non-profit association La Stella di Lorenzo allowed the Beat the Beat project, which **supports medical research** for those suffering with arrhythmogenic right ventricular cardiomyopathy, to be shared across several RAI channels. As a genetic disease that is profoundly progressive and degenerative, arrhythmogenic right ventricular cardiomyopathy is one of the main ones causes of sudden juvenile death, as such the Beat the Beat project supports research conducted in the Laboratory of Molecular Human Genetics and Genomics of the Department of Biology of the University of Padua led by Prof. Alessandra Rampazzo.



*Through the non-profit association La Stella di Lorenzo, the Beat the Beat project has financed our research over the past three years by either **establishing scholarships or funding materials and reagents for experiments**, bring forth promising pharmaceutical results. Thanks to preliminary data, we have very obtained European funding for the study of the molecular causes of arrhythmogenic cardiomyopathy and for the identification and testing of new treatments. My entire research team and I hold much gratitude to Beat the Beat project and La Stella di Lorenzo Association for their **commitment, tenacity and generosity** which has allowed us to pursue our ambitious research.*

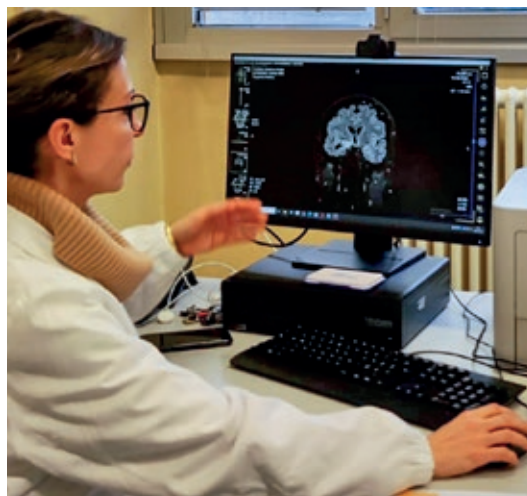
Bruno Mastrotto and the research against Parkinson's disease

Shedding light on the consequences of respiratory diseases thanks to Intesa Sanpaolo Vita

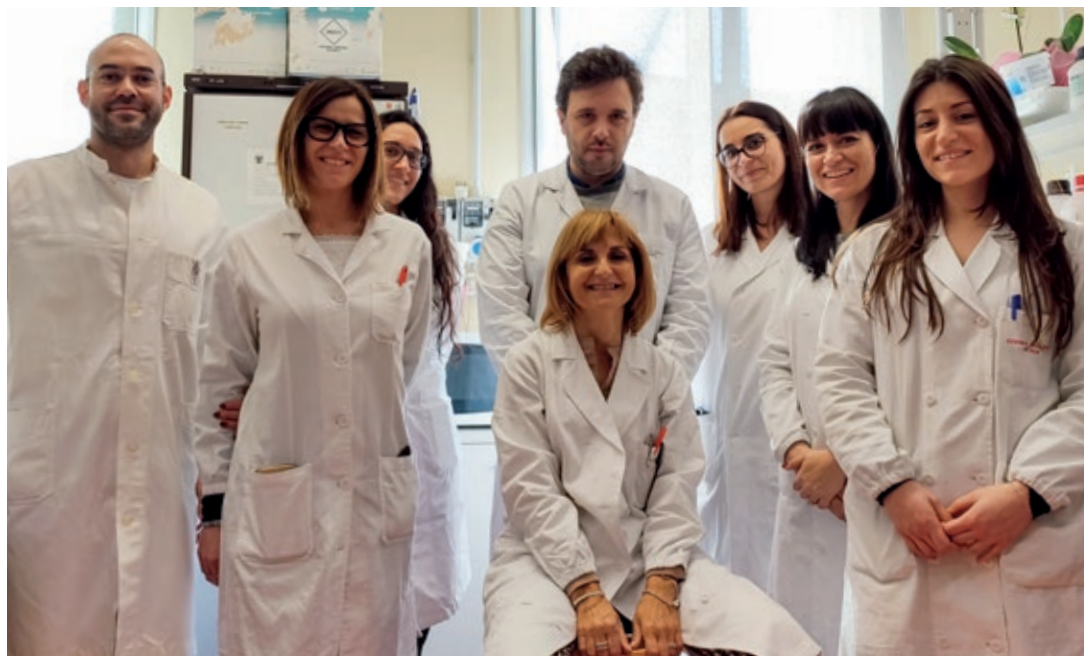
Reaching beyond the important results produced in the past year, Intesa Sanpaolo Vita S.p.A continues its commitment to the **development and promotion of scientific research** by financing the 2022 Department of Department of Cardiac, Thoracic, Vascular Sciences and Public Health Research Grant to investigate lung damage of frail patients and those suffering with respiratory disease under the scientific leadership of Prof. Fiorella Calabrese. One researcher involved in this work is Dr. Gheorghe-Emilian Olteanu.

*Winning the research grant was **the perfect moment at the right time** for me. Under the careful supervision of Prof. Calabrese and working closely with her collaborators, we managed to shed new light on what exactly happens in the lungs of patients suffering from severe COVID-19 using a special technique called bronchoalveolar lavage. We also looked at what impact COVID-19 might have on people that are plagued by cancer, and through hard work, and multidisciplinary work, we managed **to produce scientific data** that has a real-world impact on this, that will be published soon and **shared with the scientific world**. To end, my experience was **rich professionally, and really enriching personally**. I hope I will be back in Padua soon to do more work with great people.*

The Young Engineer DNV Scholarship in Memory of Vittore Marangon

In 2022, the leading certification body for management systems in Italy, DNV Business Assurance Italy S.r.l. established **a series of scholarships for the first time** in memory of the University of Padua mechanical engineering graduate Vittore Maragon who passed away in 2017 while serving as the company's Chief Executive Officer and Manager.

Three graduate students received the scholarship based on their written thesis dedicated to “Competitive advantages of adopting **Sustainable Development Goals** in the design of products, services, and production processes. Awardee, Lara Franchin, received the scholarship based on her thesis “Development of an impedance genosensor for the detection of *Campylobacter* in the agricultural food sector.”



*The electrochemical sensor I proposed for the detection of *Campylobacter* fits into the context of the Sustainable Development Goals. By reducing the environmental impact and production of waste associated with the food industry, my thesis aims at reducing health and social costs due to the infection. I am grateful to DNV for the opportunity to publicize my work, which I am continuing with my PhD.*

The Bosco 800 Project

In celebration of the eight-hundredth anniversary of its foundation, the University has undertaken to **restore the forests of the Asiago plateau destroyed by the 2018 Tempesta Vaia**. Officially entitled *Bosco degli 800 anni dell'Università di Padova*, the project was created by the Department of Land, Environment, Agriculture and Forestry (TESAF) in agreement with the Municipality of Asiago and Veneto Agricoltura. Inaugurated on 13 October 2022, the reforestation project includes eight devastated hectares of forest lands located in the historic and visible area

between Asiago and Monte Zebio, an area near and dear to the Italian author and World War II veteran Mario Rigoni Stern. Thanks to many companies and individuals, we have planted **over 5,000 young trees**, thus promoting the area's biodiversity by enriching **greater resilience and resistance** against future extreme events and climate change. With everyone's support, we will be able to complete the reforestation of the whole area, thus **leaving a permanent legacy for the benefit of the territory, the environment, and future generations**.

The 5x1000



The 5x1000 allows Italian taxpayers to support the University of Padua as a research institution. Thanks to the more than 102,000 taxpayers who selected the University of Padua for their 5x1000 pre-tax contribution, over 5 million euros have been allocated to the University of Padua since 2006. This impressive result has only grown over time.

From 2018 to 2021, the number of individual that selected the University increased by over 1,500. In particular, in 2021 (2020 income) the University received 385,328 euros thanks to the choice of 7,154 taxpayers who donated their 5x1000 to the University. **An important sign of great trust in our institution and the support of the constant work of innovation and development by many researchers.**

Among these include the Irma Battistuzzi Award, now in its sixth edition, for graduates of the School of Obstetrics who wish to gain professional experience in one of the hospitals where Doctors with Africa CUAMM operate.

Donating has its benefits, including tax benefits

For companies

Collaborating with the University of Padua is an important opportunity for corporate social responsibility (CSR), a forward-looking investment that leaves a concrete mark in every virtuous company, which adds value and concreteness to the corporate mission and which increases stakeholder consensus promoting the sense of belonging of those who work in that same company.

Tax benefits

- are deductible within the limit of 2% of business income if aimed at the establishment and social projects (art. - 100, paragraph 2, letter a) of Presidential Decree 917/1986 RM of 17 October 2008, n. 386/E).
- are fully deductible from income if aimed at supporting research (art. 1, paragraph 353 of the 2006 Finance Law).
- provide for a 65% tax break in support of culture (Art Bonus). For individuals with business income (companies and sole proprietorships) and non-commercial entities that also carry out commercial activities, the tax credit is recognized within the limit of 5x1000 of annual revenues.

For individuals

Above all, the University of Padua is a community of people (students, teachers, and administrative staff) who strongly believe in the objectives of University missions and projects.

Achieving these objectives are possible thanks to the support of individuals comprised of friends, Alumni, the local community and those who believe in the value of higher education.

Tax benefits

- are totally deductible from the total income (model 730, UNICO model) pursuant to art. 10 paragraph 1 letter I- quarter of Presidential Decree 917/1986 (TUIR);
- are deductible at 19% of the gross tax (art. 15 paragraph 1, letter I- 8th of the TUIR) if aimed at technological innovation, school and university building and the expansion of the training offer;
- provide for a 65% tax break in support of culture (Art Bonus). For persons and entities that do not carry out commercial activities (employees, retirees, professionals), the tax credit is recognized within the limit of 15% of taxable income.

For foundations

Foundations have always supported research and those who study through different forms of subsidies and historical-cultural initiatives.

Tax benefits for foundations

The Italian Revenue Agency, with resolution no. 87/E of 15 October 2015, recognizes the patronage action of banking foundations and states that, “as an exception, banking foundations can benefit from the tax credit governed by art. 1, paragraph 1, DL no. 49 83/2014, relating to the sums spent for the design and execution of the restoration and enhancement works of cultural heritage, according to the provisions of the memoranda of understanding stipulated with the local public bodies” (Art Bonus).



The Art Bonus tax credit for cultural projects

Donations in favour of maintenance, protection, or restoration of public cultural assets made by companies, individuals, or foundations benefit from the Art Bonus tax credit that is equal to 65% of the amount donated. All those who make cash donations to support culture, as required by law, enjoy important tax benefits in the form of a tax credit.



Tax benefits for residents of other European countries

Donations destined to the University by individuals and legal entities residing in other European countries made through the **Transnational Giving Europe** network can benefit from the tax advantages of their country of residence.



Tax benefits for US residents

Liberal contributions to the University from natural and legal persons residing in the United States made through the non-profit **American Friends Fund of the University of Padua** can benefit from US tax advantages.

We would also like to thank all those who prefer to remain anonymous, those who have chosen the University of Padua as the beneficiary of a will, and all those who have chosen to allocate their 5x1000 to the University.
