It is a UNIPD mobility Programme. You can find here destinations which are not present in other mobility programmes.

We have destinations in 5 continents: Europe, America, Asia, Oceania and Africa

The mobility period can last from 2 to 12 months (depending on the chosen destination). It has to be completed between 01/07/2025 and 30/09/2026.

Please check partners' availability.

Accommodation and visa procedures are students' responsibility



ULISSE PROGRAMME VS ERASMUS+



- Fundings are the main difference: European vs University/Department funds
- Ground rules are the same
- Ulisse mobility is compatible with other programs
- Erasmus+ Destinations change every year

WHO CAN APPLY?

- UNIPD regularly enrolled students: bachelor, master or PhD
 REQUREMENTS
- For bachelor/single-cycle master's degree students: at least 40 CFU already registered; 15 CFU for first year students
- For non-EU citizens: valid residence permit
- Language/specific requirements set by partners



DESTINATIONS

There are two types of destinations:

- «Di Ateneo»: every Unipd student can apply
- «Di Dipartimento»: only students from some course can apply.





You can apply for 2 destinations or 2 funding options of the same destination

Students **will win just for 1 destination** and won't appear in other rankings

Order of preference is important



Students who already went to a certain destination with Ulisse cannot apply again for the same destination

SCHOLARSHIPS

There are three types of scholarships:

- □ «Di **Ateneo**»: funded by the University
- □ «Di **Dipartimento**»: funded by the Department
- □ Zero grant: no scholarship provided







ATENEO DESTINATIONS & DEPARTMENT DESTINATIONS WITH ATENEO SCHOLARSHIPS :

- 700 euros per month
- Flat rate remboursement for travel costs

DESTINATIONS WITH DEPARTMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

- Department grant or zero grant
- Check infos in the Destination portal

Top-ups to grants according to the participants' economic situation certified by ISEE (if funds are available)

ATTENTION:

For some destination there are additional requirements

First year master students with a bachelor degree awarded by another University: attach your transcript

At least 50 % of the credits you take must be recognised as curricular activities

You have to take at least 3 ECTS



Upload the **attachments** in **PDF only:**

- Activity proposal and/or Letter for thesis and/or internship (MANDATORY) You can use the form available at this link: www.unipd.it/ulisse
- 2. LANGUAGE certificate (MANDATORY).
- 3. Cover letter (MANDATORY).
- 4. Required additional documents (check the Destination portal)
- Self certification stating high school or bachelor degree graduation grade (if obtained in another italian or foreign university)

SELECTION CRITERIA

UNIVERSITY-WIDE AGREEMENTS:

- Standard Coefficient/Merit criteria
- Commission points
- Language points

ATTENTION: students who won't upload language certificates won't be eligible

TO SUM UP:

- It is possible to apply for Ulisse and other Calls (e.g. Erasmus+, SEMP).
- If you win two Erasmus + scholarships, you must choose only one mobility. You cannot do both.
- You can do both SEMP or Ulisse mobility and the Erasmus mobility as long as the two mobility periods do not overlap
- Being selected by Unipd does not imply that your application will automatically be accepted by the partner
- Departure is always subject to the Embassy visa issue and other safety conditions
