Abstract del progetto / <i>Abstract</i>	The goal of the project is to gain knowledge, skills and experience in the identification, role and importance of water fronts as a key element in shaping urban space in the context of sustainable development. Participants will work on concepts for developing waterfront areas, drawing on interdisciplinary and international experience. Sustainability, the project's guiding idea, is based on social, economic, environmental interlocking dimensions. The problem addressed is universal in nature, and therefore applies to regions from the countries involved in the project. Each brings its own unique conditions, potentials and challenges, which will become the basis for developing solutions using problem-based learning (PBL) methodology. Methods: -Problem-Based Learning (PBL) as the core teaching method, focused on solving real problems related to waterfront development in the context of sustainable development, -Place-based approach, developing solutions grounded in local conditions, potentials and challenges of partner regions, -International and interdisciplinary teamwork, integrating perspectives of urban planning, economics, tourism, environmental protection and social issues, -Desk research and comparative analysis, -Study tours and field workshops, including observation, documentation, analysis of historical, cultural and environmental aspects, and meetings with local stakeholders, Outcomes: - Final project group presentations and reflective discussions summarising project results and lessons learned, -Knowledge, skills and practical experience in identifying the role and importance of waterfronts as key elements of urban space and sustainable local development, including climate change adaptation strategies and blue-green infrastructure,

	- Improved ability to analyse and solve complex problems related to sustainable urban development, - Competence in applying the place-based approach to urban and regional development solutions, - Development of intercultural competencies, including openness to diversity and effective collaboration in multicultural teams, - Strengthened interdisciplinary collaboration skills, combining urban planning, economics, tourism, environmental protection and social perspectives, - Establishment of international academic and professional networks supporting future research and implementation projects.
