Abstract del progetto / <i>Abstract</i>	The proposed set of classes, conceived as a summer school for students of all levels, is focused on issues related to broadly understood memory culture. The idea for this type of initiative arose from

	<p>existing international scientific and educational cooperation between the partner universities. Participants will be students of history and related fields from universities in Italy, Latvia, and Lithuania, as well as from the University of Wrocław. BIP participants will become acquainted with the interdisciplinary approach to interpreting historical events both in Central and Eastern European countries and in Western Europe. The backdrop for the seminar classes will be Wrocław – referred to in historiography as a 'city-microcosm' due to its changing fortunes, the mixing of cultures, nations, and religions, a meeting place for people from different parts of Europe throughout the centuries, and the extreme impact of post-World War II displacements in Europe. Experts representing several scientific disciplines - history, art history, and literature - will participate in the discussions. It will be an opportunity for all participants to strengthen the existing network of contacts and to initiate new educational and research initiatives.</p> <p>Participants will become acquainted with the latest innovative trends in memory culture research. The analysis and discussion will focus on identity discourses and the historical narratives contained within them, adapted to new contexts under changing circumstances from a comparative perspective. Discussions will revolve around sites of memory (Lieux de mémoire), the question of national and regional dimensions of memory, memory in literature, and history as an instrument of political legitimacy. The BIP program will include seminar sessions, as well as workshops in Wrocław's museum and library institutions, and exploration of sites of memory in the Wrocław area.</p> <p>Objectives and expected learning outcome</p> <p>Participants from individual countries will have the opportunity to exchange experiences (and observations) on memory research in Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, and Poland. Notably, experts from all four countries representing various specializations (history, art history, literary studies) and eras within their disciplines (early modern period, 20th-century history) will take part. An additional benefit will be the dissemination of the first research attempts conducted by PhD students and students, as well as joint discussions on methodology and ways of achieving results. Furthermore, the participation of students and PhD candidates in the BIP will contribute to the development of their communication skills in English.</p>
