Course Title and Description

Summer School on Language Acquisition to benefit the Global South

The aim of the Summer Scholl is to promote the knowledge of language acquisition in different regions of the world. The Summer School will last five days and is organized into 4 didactic units to be developed each day.

For each day and for each didactic unit (perception, vocabulary, syntax acquisition and social interaction) a recognized expert will give a lecture.

The programme also includes in-depth theoretical and methodological seminars in order to enrich each topic and to encourage the debate. Among the methodological topics different experiences in a variety of research activities are planned, among which the conduct of online experimental studies with children, the processing and the analysis of the Corpus Open Source data with the use of cutting-edge statistical software and support in the planning of the study. The activities will be exclusively virtual with a mixture of synchronous and asynchronous events, in order to promote the attendance of the students in the different time zones.

At the end of the summer school, students will have acquired knowledge of the current theories and controversies and will have learnt basic experimental methods to develop their studies, according to current scientific standards.
