Course Title and Description

WPL DD LINE. A platform to support double degree schemes

The DD Line project is a student-led virtual platform available to enrolled and prospective double degree students. They can share information and experiences, meet scholars and resource persons to support their academic undertaking, and affine linguistic and intercultural skills. It also provides lecturers and management staff with a platform to share initiatives of common interest and meet potential new partners. The project targets students participating in the double degree Master course in Human Rights and Multi-level Governance, other students in the master's courses of the three universities willing to apply to the double degree calls and scholars from other universities who wish to establish double degree schemes in the field of international studies and human rights.

WPL DD Line is articulated into the following actions and connected outcomes – at least three of such activities should be implemented in the coming a.y.

a) The setting, populating, and maintaining a Moodle channel likely to be accessed by students at the three institutions and dedicated to double degree activities.

b) Producing a series of recorded lectures offered by scholars in Wroclaw, Lyon (and Grenoble-Alpes), and Padova, providing insights on some subjects that characterize the educational offer in the respective master's courses (two videos per partner).

c) Produce a video or podcast on the respective experiences, challenges, and tips for prospective participants. Contributions can be realised by single students, a single university group of students or cross-university teams. Depending on their content and target, they can be published either in Moodle or on social media platforms. At least three videos/audios should be produced.

d) Establishing and animating a linguistic and intercultural online workshop. On this forum, students from the three universities engage in a dialogue concerning soft skills (intercultural competencies, sharing experiences on the different European and non-European university systems), linguistic competencies (English and French for academic purposes; communication competences in Italian, Polish, and other languages). At least three online workshops will be called with the active contribution of double degree students, targeting and with the participation of mates from the partner universities. If feasible, workshops would be organised in dual form: students may meet physically at their hosting university and be offered some refreshments.

e) Creating a repository of resources and good practices to develop more double degree or similar initiatives with other universities, particularly non-European universities in Latin America, Africa, and Asia. To this end, a connection can be created with the network on law and development established by the Law School of the University of Antwerp.
