Educational Procedures for the 2nd and 3rd trimester and the 2nd semester of the 2021/2022 Academic Year

The Rector, presiding as the President of the Academic Senate, announces a few changes in the educational procedures for the second and third trimester and second semester of the 2021/2022 Academic Year.

Please refer to the <u>Guidelines for conducting exams and graduation</u> ceremonies published in January 2022.

Educational procedure for classes held during the second and third trimester and second semester of the 2021/2022 Academic Year. Conducting all degree course lessons – including master and single-cycle master degree courses of the University – as follows:

- Lessons will continue to be delivered in person and online simultaneously; recordings of the lessons will be made available by the teachers through the University platform
- lessons of an experimental nature (such as workshops, exercises, and other methods of experimenting) will be delivered exclusively in person

Following instructions previously provided by the University, please note that classrooms access is restricted only to students in possession of a valid Green Pass. As a reminder, this includes students under the age of 50 with a Basic Green Pass vaccination level or negative swab results, and students over the age of 50 with a Super Green Pass vaccination level. Students are exempt from participating in the CoVid-19 vaccination campaign only if they hold a valid medical certificate.

As per the Italian Ministerial Decree, to access any University building or facility, random checks will be carried out in the period indicated to verify possession of a Green Pass or medical certificate of exemption. If requested, students are required to show a valid certification or Green Pass to access University buildings.

During lessons, the <u>Protocols for the Control and Containment of SARS-CoV-2</u> must be followed and attendance will be registered using the OrariUnipd app.
