<b>Course Title and Description</b>	<b>Curriculum Enhancement through an international Problem Based Learning experience in Veterinary Medicine</b>  This initiative is addressed to third year students of the Master degree course in Veterinary Medicine and it consists of an intensive training week on soft skills and crosscutting issues linked to the three main area of veterinary medicine (Companion Animals Medicine; Farm Animals Medicine; Public Health). The course will be taught in English and will be held in Summer (26 – 30 July 2021). A maximum of 12 students per University will attend. They will be divided into three groups of at most 12 students (at most 4 students per University). Each group will analyse two case studies related to their main area through the Problem Based Learning (PBL). They will be helped by the constant presence of a facilitator (a young expert in the field) and in the final part they will debate with the professors of the same main area. At the beginning, in the middle and at the end of the course plenary sessions are planned in order to present the Universities, the PBL method and the case studies to be analysed by the three groups and to deliver three seminars linked to the case studies. The plenary sessions will be open to the whole veterinary medicine academic community, both in synchronous videoconferencing and through the upload of the registered material in the relevant websites.
