

## Information For Receiving The EU Digital COVID Green Certificate

### What is it?

The EU Digital COVID Green Certificate is The European Commission proposal that facilitates the free and safe movement of citizens in the European Union in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Verifications are made available through digital and printable (paper) certification that contain two-dimensional barcodes (QR Code) and a qualified electronic seal issued only through the Italian Ministry of Health platform.

### How to get it?

The EU Digital COVID Green Certificate is available to those who can fulfill the following prerequisites:

- those **who have been vaccinated against COVID-19**: in Italy, the first dose is valid up to the date of the second dose, and extended up to the completion of the vaccination cycle, which remains valid for 9 months
- those **with a negative test result**, which is valid for 48 hours
- those **recovered from COVID-19 with a certification**, which is valid for 6 months

**Download** The EU Digital COVID Green Certificate from:

- the Italian Ministry of Health platform ([www.dgc.gov.it](http://www.dgc.gov.it)) select "*Certificati*"
- the App Immuni
- the IO App IO
- the Regional Electronic Health Record (tbd)

**Those without access the digital tools indicated above and hold a valid Italian identification health card (*tessera sanitaria*)** can request certification from:

- Pharmacies
- Family and General Practitioners

Procedure for **foreign citizens enrolled in the Italian national health service** should follow the same as Italian citizens stated above.

For people **not registered with the Italian national health service, but who have been vaccinated in Italy**, and are in possession of the tax code and the date of the last vaccination can The EU Digital COVID Green Certificate through the following link
