Goals



- → Increasing the salary related to any PhD fellowships
 - Overcoming <u>PhD positions without scholarships</u>
- → Recognition of the PhD as a job
 - Extending the <u>social welfare</u> conditions of workers to researchers with temporary contracts
 - Reaching an agreement with the university to <u>cover the</u> <u>national health service</u> fee for international PhD students
- → Valorisation of the PhD title: public administration and industry
- → Organization of cultural activities for young researchers



Achievement

Ilaborating with the Representation and Governance

COVID period

- → 33/34/35/36th cycle → 3 months paid extension
- → International PhD → smart working in the country of origin
- → PhD scholarship increase from €15,343.28 to €16,243.00 (1 July 2022)
- → Bonus una tantum + Bonus Aiuti-ter extented to PhD students
- → 100% of PhD scholarship is covered for maternity
- → introduction of the **mediator**
- → salary payment anticipation (from 20th to 5th of each month)
- → DIS-COLL up to 12 months from January 2022
