

### 1.2 Admission requirements

To access the degree programmes referred to in this Call for admission, candidates must:

1. Be in possession of a **first-level university degree** (bachelor's degree, single-cycle master's degree, university diploma or equivalent) **obtained in Italy by 29 January 2027** and recognized as suitable according to current legislation.  
Those who access using an entry title obtained abroad must follow the deadlines and procedures shown on page <https://www.unipd.it/ammissione-studenti-internazionali>.
2. be in possession of the **minimum curricular requirements** and **personal preparation** required for each degree programme as reported in [Annex 1](#).
3. **pre-enrol** in the period **15 July 2026 (3:00 pm) – 29 January 2027 (12:00 pm)** following the procedures set out in [point 2](#);
4. submit the minimum curricular requirements application in the period **15 July 2026 (12:00 noon) – 29 January 2027 (3:00 pm)** following the procedures set out in [point 3](#);



5. submit an application for **enrolment, change of degree programme or transfer** in accordance with the procedures and deadlines set out in [point 4](#).

## 2. REGISTRATION AND PRE-ENROLMENT ON THE UNIWEB PORTAL

### 2.1 Registration on the Uniweb portal

If you are accessing Uniweb for the first time, you must create a new account by clicking on [www.uniweb.unipd.it](http://www.uniweb.unipd.it) and on *Menu → Registration*.

At the end of the registration, you will receive an e-mail username and activation code with which to access the [uniweb.unipd.it/password/index.php/it/utenti/identifica/azione/a](http://uniweb.unipd.it/password/index.php/it/utenti/identifica/azione/a) page, where you will be asked to set three security questions and a password. With the username obtained and the password set, you can access your reserved area.

Registration on the [www.uniweb.unipd.it](http://www.uniweb.unipd.it) portal can also be done using SPID credentials, by clicking on *Menu → Registration with SPID*.

### 2.2 Submitting the pre-enrolment application

The application must be submitted **by the deadline indicated in [point 1.2](#)**.

To pre-enrol you must:

1. log in with your credentials to [www.uniweb.unipd.it](http://www.uniweb.unipd.it) and click on the items *Home > Evaluation test > Degree programme Type "Master's Degree programme"* and indicate the degree programme of interest;
2. enter the degree to be used for access to the degree programme, if not already present in the system.

**Students enrolled at the University of Padua** who are about to graduate can complete pre-enrolment only after submitting the online application for the degree. In the event that this application has not yet been submitted, in order to proceed, it is necessary to report your situation to [immatricolazioni.studenti@unipd.it](mailto:immatricolazioni.studenti@unipd.it);

3. at the same time, pay the pre-enrolment fee of € 30.00 through the PagoPA procedure (instructions on page [www.unipd.it/pago-pa](http://www.unipd.it/pago-pa)).

### 3. KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED FOR ACCESS AND APPLICATION FOR ASSESSMENT

To access the chosen degree programme, it is necessary to be in possession of specific minimum curricular requirements and adequate personal preparation, as required by the teaching regulations of each degree programme. The complete sheet of each degree programme is available in [Annex 1](#).

This knowledge is verified through the submission of a specific application for the assessment of minimum curricular requirements.

In order to apply for an assessment of the requirements, **it is first necessary** to have submitted a **pre-enrolment application**, within the deadlines and in the manner indicated in [point 2](#).

If you intend to compete for access to more than one degree programme, you must submit an application for the assessment of minimum curricular requirements (in addition to the related pre-enrolment) for each of the degree programmes of your interest.

The minimum curricular requirements application must be submitted **by the deadline indicated in [point 1.2](#)**.

## 4. ENROLMENT, CHANGE OF DEGREE PROGRAMME, TRANSFER FROM ANOTHER UNIVERSITY

### 4.1 Procedure and deadlines

In order to enrol, change degree programme or transfer from another university, it is necessary to:

- have submitted the pre-enrolment application ([point 2](#));
- have submitted the minimum curricular requirements application ([point 3](#)) and be in possession of the required requirements;
- have verified the registration of the data regarding the entry title in the Uniweb reserved area. Registration takes place automatically for graduates from the University of Padua; graduates from other universities must update their graduation data in the Uniweb reserved area in the *Home > Qualifications* section by 29 January 2027.

The application for **enrolment** must be submitted

- from 15:00 on 15 July and **by 15 February<sup>2</sup> 2027** (full day).

The application for **incoming transfer** must be submitted:

- from 15:00 on 15 July and **by 30 October 2026** (full day).

The application for **a change of degree programme** must be submitted:

- from 15:00 on 1 September and **by 30 October 2026** (full day).

In order to be able to request a change of degree programme or an incoming transfer within the deadline indicated above, it is therefore necessary, again by 30 October 2026, to have submitted the pre-enrolment application (1), the minimum curricular requirements application obtaining eligibility (2) and to have obtained and updated the entry title on the Uniweb portal (3). In order to access the degree programmes after this date, if you are already enrolled in another degree programme at this or another university, you must follow the withdrawal and re-enrolment procedures. #### 4.2 Student Fees and Benefits

For new enrolments, the amount of the first instalment of the university fee includes 16.00 euros of stamp duty and the regional tax for the right to university education, of about 200 euros, updated annually by the Veneto Region.

### 5. RECOGNITION OF CREDITS FOR CAREER SHORTENING

It is possible to request the recognition of activities and exams taken (including abroad), such as single courses or in previous university careers, so that you do not have to take them again in the degree programme. To apply for recognition, you must:

- submit the pre-enrolment application ([point 2](#));
- submit the application for evaluation of the minimum curricular requirements ([point 3](#)). Within the portal there is a special section for submitting the application for recognition of credits for career shortening; Candidates with a qualification belonging to an old system can refer to the contacts referred to in point 4 for information on this matter. The application for credit recognition can only be submitted after obtaining eligibility for curricular requirements. The deadlines within which to proceed coincide with those indicated for the period of evaluation of curricular requirements.

The commission in charge evaluates the application submitted and issues a resolution indicating the year of admission proposed to the chosen degree programme, on the basis of the credits recognized:

## 6. PERSON IN CHARGE OF THE PROCEDURE, PERSONAL DATA, NOTES AND WARNINGS

1. Pursuant to art. 4 of Law 241 of 7 August 1990 (New rules on administrative procedure and right of access to administrative documents) and subsequent amendments, the President of the Degree programme or the Commission in charge of evaluation is appointed as the person responsible for the administrative access procedure.
2. Responsible for the Access to Records Procedure: Head of the Ufficio Carriere Studenti, Dr. Maria Chiara Ferraresi.
3. Current legislation on declarations: in the event that the documentation submitted by the candidate shows false or misleading declarations, without prejudice to the sanctions provided for by the Criminal Code and the special laws on the subject (Articles 75 and 76 of Presidential Decree 445/2000), the candidate automatically loses his/her enrolment. The University will recover any benefits granted (e.g. scholarships) and will not proceed with any type of refund of the fees paid. Finally, the false declaration will result in the exposure to the action for damages by the counterparties.
4. Processing of personal data: the personal data provided by candidates, collected for the purposes identified in this Call for admission, are processed in compliance with the provisions of EU Regulation 27.04.2016, n. 679 (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR) and the information available on page [www.unipd.it/informativa-studenti](http://www.unipd.it/informativa-studenti).
