Selections are open for admission to the first year of the Master's Degree Programmes with limited access of the Scuola di Ingegneria¹ indicated in the table below, for the academic year 2026/27. The degree programmes are delivered in English.

Places reserved for non-EU candidates residing abroad who remain vacant due to a complete scrolling of the rankings are put up for competition in the first useful scrolling of the ranking list for EU or equivalent candidates.

¹ The activation of the first year of the courses of study is subject to their accreditation in accordance with the provisions of Ministerial Decree 1154/2021 "Self-assessment, evaluation, initial and periodic accreditation of locations and courses of study"; therefore the course will not be activated in the event of non-accreditation. The activation of any curricula is also subject to the achievement of a minimum number of 5 students enrolled for each of them. 1.2 Admission requirements

To be eligible, candidates must:

1. obtain **a three-year degree in Italy or an equivalent foreign qualification** by 31 December 2026², according to current legislation.
2. Be in possession of the **curricular requirements** and **personal preparation** required, as indicated in [point 4](#);
3. **Participate in the selection** process by following the procedures and deadlines indicated in [point 2](#);
4. **Be admitted**: the ranking list and any assignments and repechages are published on the dates and pages provided for by each selection;
5. **Enrol**: admitted candidates must submit an application for enrolment, change of degree programme or transfer from another university within the peremptory deadlines set by each selection.

1.3 Criteria for the formation of the admission ranking list

The admission rankings for the first year are determined in order of score, given by the weighted average of the exams relating to the following SSDs, taking into consideration a minimum of credits for each of the following SSDs/groups of SSDs:

- ICAR/01,02: 9 CFU
- ICAR/08,09: 9 CFU
- ICAR/07: 4 CFU
- ICAR/04,05,06,10,17,20: 12 CFU
- MAT/07,08, ING-IND/10,11,22, SECS-S/01, CHIM/07: 8 CFU

In the event of a tie, priority is given to the youngest candidate.

Only the credits indicated in the academic documentation sent when sending the application are considered.

The ranking list is drawn up in order of score on a basis of 100 by normalizing the weighted average of each candidate. Only suitable candidates are included in the rankings, who have therefore fully carried out the operations indicated for each selection ([point 2](#)) and who have obtained a minimum score of **60/100**.

2.1 Selection: deadlines and procedures

2.2 Further selection: deadlines and procedures

Enabling a Further Selection

It is possible to activate a further selection for candidates who have not participated in the procedures by the deadlines of the first selection.

The ranking list of this selection will be used, in order of score, **only after** the scrolling of the ranking list of the first selection has concluded and **only if there are still places available**.

If the commission considers that the ranking of the first selection is sufficient to cover all the places, the further selection **will not be activated**.

To participate in the selection and access the degree programme it is necessary to:

1. **pre-enrol** ([point 3](#)) in the period **15 July – 28 August 2026 (12:00 noon)**;
2. submit the application for **assessment of curricular requirements** in the period **15 July – 28 August 2026 (12:00 noon)** ([point 4](#));
3. **submit the required language documentation** ([Annex 2](#)) by **30 September 2026**;
4. **Be admitted**: the rankings of each degree programme and subsequent assignments are published on the dates and pages indicated in the table below. The publication has the value of official communication to interested parties;
5. **Enrol**: the application for enrolment, change of degree programme or transfer from another university must be submitted within the deadlines indicated in the table below. The procedures to be followed are indicated in [point 5](#).

The number of places available for the further selection is published depending on the trend of the ranking of the first selection, on the first available date starting from **15 July**.

At the same time, if the selection is activated, information is provided regarding the deadlines for access to the degree programme for admitted candidates and the planned reassignments.

3. REGISTRATION AND PRE-ENROLMENT ON THE UNIWEB PORTAL

The pre-enrolment application is completed by accessing the www.uniweb.unipd.it portal

on the dates indicated for the selection ([point 2](#)).

3.1 Registration on the Uniweb portal

If you are accessing Uniweb for the first time, you must create a new account by clicking on www.uniweb.unipd.it and on *Menu → Registration*.

At the end of the registration, you will receive an e-mail username and activation code with which to access the uniweb.unipd.it/password/index.php/it/utenti/identifica/azione/a page, where you will be asked to set three security questions and a password. With the username obtained and the password set, you can access your reserved area.

Registration on the www.uniweb.unipd.it portal can also be done using SPID credentials, by clicking on the *Menu → items Registrazione con SPID*.

Please note: The personal e-mail address entered in your Uniweb profile is the communication channel through which any deadlines and useful instructions for accessing the degree programme are provided. E-mails sent for this purpose have the value of official communication.

3.2 Submitting the pre-enrolment application

1. log in with your credentials to www.uniweb.unipd.it, click on *the items Home → Admission Test → Degree programme Type "Master's Degree programme" → Intelligent Civil Infrastructure Engineering – Further selection*;
2. enter the degree to be used for access to the degree programme, if not already present in the system.

Students enrolled at the University of Padua who are about to graduate can complete the pre-enrolment application only after submitting the online application for the degree. In the event that this application has not yet been submitted, in order to proceed, it is necessary to report your situation to immatricolazioni.studenti@unipd.it;

3. at the same time, pay the pre-enrolment fee of € 30.00 through the PagoPA procedure (instructions on page www.unipd.it/pago-pa).

4. KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED FOR ACCESS

4.1 Procedures

To access the degree programme, it is necessary to be in possession of specific minimum curricular requirements and adequate personal preparation, as indicated in the degree programme regulations. For the verification of this knowledge, it is necessary to meet the requirements as set out in the following point (4.2) by submitting the required documents, if necessary.



The procedure is available only after completing pre-enrolment ([point 3](#)) on the dates set for the selection ([point 2](#)).

The **instructions** for submitting the application for assessment of the requirements are published on 15 July 2026 on page <https://www.unipd.it/ammissione-icie>.

4.2 Minimum curricular requirements and personal preparation

This requirement must be met as indicated by **at least one of the two proposed alternatives**:

- a. possession of a degree in class L-7 (DM 270/04) or a degree in class 8 (DM 509/99)
- b. achievement of a minimum of University Educational Credits (CFU) divided as follows in the following SSDs:
 - At least 6 credits: ICAR/01 (CEAR-01/A)
 - At least 6 CFU: ICAR/02 (CEAR-01/B)
 - At least 6 CFU: ICAR/08 (CEAR-06/A)
 - At least 6 credits: ICAR/09 (CEAR-07/A)
 - At least 4 credits: ICAR/07 (CEAR-05/A)
 - At least 12 credits: ICAR/04 (CEAR-03/A), ICAR/05 (CEAR-03/B), ICAR/06 (CEAR-04/A), ICAR/10 (CEAR-08/A), ICAR/17 (CEAR-10/A), ICAR/20 (CEAR-12/A)
 - At least 8 CFU: MAT/07 (MATH-04/A), MAT/08 (MATH-05/A), ING-IND/10 (IIND-07/A), ING-IND/11 (IIND-07/B), SECS-S/01 (STAT-01/A), CHIM/07 (CHEM-06/A), ING-IND/22 (IMAT-01/A)

All candidates are also required to possess:

- Weighted average mark **of 24/30** reported in the courses pertaining to the following SSDs: ICAR/01 (CEAR-01/A), ICAR/02 (CEAR-01/B), ICAR/08 (CEAR-06/A), ICAR/09 (CEAR-07/A), ICAR/07 (CEAR-05/A), ICAR/04 (CEAR-03/A), ICAR/05 (CEAR-03/B), ICAR/06 (CEAR-04/A), ICAR/10 (CEAR-08/A), ICAR/17 (CEAR-10/A), ICAR/20 (CEAR-12/A), MAT/07 (MATH-04/A), MAT/08 (MATH-05/A), ING-IND/10 (IIND-07/A), ING-IND/11 (IIND-07/B), SECS-S/01 (STAT-01/A), CHIM/07 (CHEM-06/A), ING-IND/22 (IMAT-01/A);
- Knowledge of the **English language at level B2 or higher**, verified as indicated in [Annex 2](#).

5. ENROLMENT, CHANGE OF COURSE, TRANSFER FROM ANOTHER UNIVERSITY

5.1 Procedures

In order to enrol, change courses or transfer from another university, it is necessary to:

- have submitted the pre-enrolment application ([point 3](#));
- have submitted the application for assessment of the requirements ([point 4](#)) and be in possession of the required requirements;
- submit the documentation for the language requirement ([Annex 2](#)) within the deadlines set by the selection;
- be "admitted (ammesso)" in the ranking;
- have registered the data of the obtained entry title. Registration is automatic for students who obtain the admission qualification at the University of Padua, while it must be completed manually for graduates from other universities in the Uniweb reserved area in the *Home* → *Titoli di accesso* section.



Admitted candidates who do not yet meet the **language requirement** ([Annex 2](#)) and/or who have not yet obtained the **entry title** may accept the place won **provisionally**.

Both of these requirements must be met for the selection referred to in this call:

- entry title: **by 31 December 2026**;
- Language requirement: **by 30 September 2026**.

The enrolment, degree programme change, or transfer application must be submitted

on the dates scheduled for each assignment ([point 2](#)).

The enrolment procedures for standard enrolment, change of degree programme and transfer from another university are shown on page www.unipd.it/istruzioniaccesso-triennali-magistrali-ciclounico.

If the qualification is not obtained and updated within the deadlines, the enrolment application is declared automatically forfeited and cancelled.

Please note: the deadlines indicated for the acceptance of the place, for the payment of the first instalment of the fees, for the obtainment and update of the entry title and for submitting the required documents are peremptory. Failure to comply is equivalent to **renunciation of the place in the ranking** list and the cancellation of the enrolment application.

Those who have missed a deadline but are interested in the degree programme can submit an application for extraordinary enrolment which is evaluated at the end of the enrolment of the last scheduled selection. The enrolment procedures for the degree programme are effective only after completion by the Ufficio Carriere Studenti – Settore Immatricolazioni e Prove di Accesso; a confirmation e-mail is sent to the e-mail address registered on the Uniweb portal.

6. PERSON IN CHARGE OF THE PROCEDURE, PERSONAL DATA, NOTES AND WARNINGS

1. Pursuant to art. 4 of Law 241 of 7 August 1990 (New rules on administrative procedure and right of access to administrative documents) and subsequent amendments, the President of the Degree programme or the Commission in charge of evaluation is appointed as the person responsible for the administrative access procedure.
2. Responsible for the Access to Records Procedure: Head of the Ufficio Carriere Studenti, Dr. Maria Chiara Ferraresi.
3. Current legislation on declarations: in the event that the documentation submitted by the candidate shows false or misleading declarations, without prejudice to the sanctions provided for by the Criminal Code and the special laws on the subject (Articles 75 and 76 of Presidential Decree 445/2000), the candidate automatically loses his/her enrolment. The University will recover any benefits granted (e.g. scholarships) and will not proceed with any type of refund of the fees paid. Finally, the false declaration will result in the exposure to the action for damages by the counterparties.
4. Processing of personal data: the personal data provided by candidates, collected for the purposes identified in this Notice, are processed in compliance with the provisions of EU Regulation 27.04.2016, n. 679 (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR) and the information available on page www.unipd.it/informativa-studenti.

ANNEX 1 – RECOGNITION OF CREDITS FOR CAREER SHORTENING

Those who intend to access the degree programme by requesting the recognition of credits must meet the access requirements for the first year. The requirements must be met **by the deadlines of the first selection** (call for admission with instructions on page: <https://www.unipd.it/ammissioni-icie>), **from 10 March to 10 April 2026**.

Once the eligibility for the requirements has been obtained, a specific application for evaluation must also be submitted for the recognition of credits already acquired and the career shortening. Instructions and deadlines are published on March 10, 2026 on page <https://www.unipd.it/ammissioni-icie>.

For the academic year 2026/27, only the first year of the degree programme referred to in this call for admission is active; the admission proposed in the resolution can therefore only take place for access to the first year regardless of the credits recognized.

ANNEX 2 – LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

To be admitted to the course, it is necessary to have and demonstrate a knowledge of the **English language of level equal to or higher than B2 (CEFR) by 30 September**.

For candidates who access with **an Italian entry title**, the requirement can be met in one of the following ways:

Alternative 1:	Possession of a language certification of level B2 or higher . The list of accepted certifications and the score thresholds to refer to are indicated on page www.unipd.it/requisito-inglese-ammissione . Certificates obtained on or after January 1, 2021 are accepted.
	<i>Required documentation</i> It is necessary to attach the certification, both sides of the page, within the procedure (point 4). Those who have taken the test and have not yet received the certificate can present the provisional statement of results issued by the certifying body.

Or

Alternative 2:	Be a native English speaker . A native speaker is considered to be a person who has an identity document indicating one of the following nationalities (dual citizenship is also considered valid in this sense): Antigua and Barbuda, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Canada, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Ireland, Jamaica, Malta, New Zealand, St Kitts and Nevis, St Lucia, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, United Kingdom, USA.
	<i>Required documentation</i> It is necessary to attach an identity document in the appropriate section of the procedure that shows the possession of the citizenship in question.

Or

Alternative 3:	Possession of a qualification of a degree programme entirely taught in English . The qualifications accepted are bachelor's degree, single-cycle master's degree, master's degree, or equivalent (foreign qualifications or previous systems); <u>it is not enough to have completed part of the course abroad</u> .
	<i>Required documentation</i> The achievement of the degree must be demonstrated by attaching the self-certification with exams or the diploma supplement provided by the university where it was obtained within the procedure (point 4).
	If the qualification in question (presented for the sole purpose of passing the language requirement) was obtained abroad, the Transcript of Records and the final diploma of achievement are required.
	In any case, the document must explicitly indicate the language of delivery of the course. Otherwise, it is necessary to attach an official document issued by the university certifying the language of delivery of the course.

Alternative 4:	Possession of an open badge issued by an Italian university or a certificate from a Language Centre (CLA) of an Italian university ³ .
	<p><i>Required documentation</i></p> <p>The certificate or open badge must be attached in the appropriate section of the procedure (point 4). It is specified that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The language certificate must be written on the letterhead of the Language Centre of the Italian University that issued it, must contain the student's personal details and must clearly indicate that the student has passed a B2 level test or higher taken at the same University Language Centre (Italian) that issued it. <p>Alternatively, within the procedure, it is possible to self-declare that you have passed the test provided by the university language centre for the level of English required. It is necessary to upload a file containing your personal details, the date of passing the test, the name of the university language center where the test was taken and the contacts of the center in question or the office that manages the delivery of the test (email address and telephone number) for the necessary checks on what has been declared.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the open badge must contain the student's personal details and must show the level of the exam, B2 or higher; You can attach the pdf of the Open Badge or a document that shows the link (URL) in which it can be consulted.

Alternative 5:	Passing the TAL B2 reading and listening test provided by the CLA (University Language Centre) of the University of Padua
	<p>The information you need to register for the test is available on page https://cla.unipd.it/test-linguistici/futuri-studenti/.</p> <p><i>Required documentation</i></p> <p>Upload a self-declaration with the date of taking the TAL test within the procedure (point 4).</p>

³ Any English language exams/qualifications taken during the university career that have not led to the issuance of an open badge are, therefore, **in no case** considered valid.
