



First Training Event: Preventive Early Career Education February 17-19, 2020, University of Padova

Dear coordinators and members of the Task 2.1 'Preventive Early Career Education', The First Training event at University of Padova will be an opportunity to engage in a collaborative workgroup series with the purpose of learning about the challenges, activities, and policies of career education in each country.

Six workgroup sessions have been organized, focused on the following six topics. During each workgroup sessions, participants will be invited to speak about the situation and experience of own home country. After the Training event, based on each University partner' synthesis and the discussion on workgroup sessions, a general report will be elaborated.

Topics to be Discussed in The First Training Event

Topic 1: Main Fears and Challenges Experienced by Young People in their Country (e.g., How many youth are outside the training system? What difficulties do they experience in accessing to the current world of work? What concerns they experience about their career future?).

Topic 2: Organization of the school and university system

(e.g., How is organized the educational system? How does the transition from middle school to high school work? What are the types of high schools? Is there a system of access to university?).

Topic 3: Overview of Career Guidance

(e.g., Are there specific legislations supporting career guidance? Are there any career guidance centers/agencies/services? What career guidance actions are carried out? Who are the target groups of people involved in career guidance activities?)

Topic 4: Career Guidance and Inclusion

(e.g., What is the educational and employment situation of young people with disabilities and vulnerabilities? What barriers do they experience in the school system and in the current world of work? Are they involved in career guidance activities? Do students with disabilities attend common schools? How many attend university and what educational and career paths?)

Topic 5: Accreditation frameworks for professionals delivering career guidance (e.g., Who is in charge of career guidance? What training is provided? What is the







training path to become a career professional? Is a regulated profession? What is the role of teachers in career guidance activities?)

Topic 6: Good Career Education Practices

(e.g., Which career guidance actions are carried out by your university? Who provides these actions? Towards which target groups? Which theoretical scientific framework do you adhere to?)
